ORGANIZE CITY CLUB, PURPOSE OUTLINED

7.—To act as a permanent, non-political organization, confining its activities to the principles of good government rather than the personalities of candidates.

8.—To advocate and insist upon the administration of public affairs in the most economical manner possible, consistent with efficient administration.

In line with these objects, the club's motto as provided for in the by-laws is the same as that engraved over the main entrance of the new city hall, "The Salvation of the Community Is the Watchfulness of the Citizen."

Non-Political

As definitely stated in the by-laws, it is the intention of the club to maintain a non-political attitude towards all civic affairs and to refrain from participation in any political campaign. In this connection it is interesting to note that any person manifesting an interest in the objects of the club is eligible to membership, "except an officer, agent, or employe of any municipal or quasi-municipal corporation having jurisdiction only over any territory within, and/or over the same area as the City of Highland Park." The by-laws further provide for the cancellation of the membership of any member who may accept such an office.

The control of the activities of the club is vested in a board of trustees consisting of twenty-four members representing the varied interests in Highland Park, a large board having been formed in order to provide representation from all parts of the city and to prevent domination by an individual or faction. The board as elected includes eight attorneys who will be formed into a legal committee to advise the board relative to the conduct of its activities and in civic matters.
