

COUNTY HOSPITAL IS FACTOR IN AFFAIRS

Supervisors to Be Sounded on Their Attitude Before Board Organizes

Demands will be made upon any candidates for chairmanship of the county board, which will be reorganized April 23, to shake-up the county hospital committee before they will get the support of a sizeable group of board members who are organizing to bring harmony for at least a year on the county hospital fight.

Supervisor William J. Obee, of Highland Park, mentioned as the successor of the present chairman, Supervisor C. H. Stratton, of Lake Villa will be waited on by a delegation, says a Waukegan report, so that his views on a change on the committee can be obtained.

Cite County Control

Supervisors and assistants who are banding for a shake-up contend that this committee has been under the control of the west half of the county for years and that the local representatives on the board have to stand the brunt of the attack on the hospital policy although they have no direct connection with the operation of the institution.

The board has been under the fire of the Waukegan Taxpayers's association and the Lake County Medical society for almost a year with the demand that the policies at the hospital be changed.

Obee, it was indicated today, might be the lone candidate for the board as Supervisor Matt P. Dilger declared that he did not believe that he would run although there are a number in the Waukegan delegation who are talking of placing Dilger in the field in an effort to get a Waukegan man as chairman. This position has gone to western representatives on the board for years.

Stanton Not to Run

Supervisor Frank Stanton, Grant, would be a certain winner if he chose to run, it is said by members, but Stanton has refused to become a candidate.

County Offices Need More Room; To Occupy Memorial Hall Section

All patriotic organizations now meeting in Memorial Hall at the county building in Waukegan are being instructed to seek other meeting places because the county requires the space for other purposes, it is reported.

While official notice has not yet been given the American Legion post, appointed as custodian of the hall, other organizations have been notified but a definite date for their removal has not yet been given.

Unofficially it has been explained that the addition of women jurors is the cause of the ouster of special sleeping quarters must be arranged for women jurors on cases that require the locking up of the jury overnight.

Col. Smith to Move

It is reported that the state's at-

torney's office will be moved to Memorial hall on the ground floor of the county building while his present offices on the third floor will be converted into sleeping quarters for women jurors. Just when the change will take place has not been announced.

Memorial hall was set aside six years ago, at the time the county building was remodeled, as a meeting place for the Grand Army veterans and other patriotic organizations. It

was reported at the time that the hall would be available to the G. A. R. veterans as long as any remained to hold meetings there. Whether the county will furnish other quarters for the G. A. R. vets has not been disclosed.

The Legion was made custodian of the hall in order that other organizations meeting there would assist in paying for the extra janitor service required.
