 Mother and Daughter banquet: A very outstanding event, with an unusual program. Date, Tuesday evening, May 12 at 6:30 p.m. All reser-

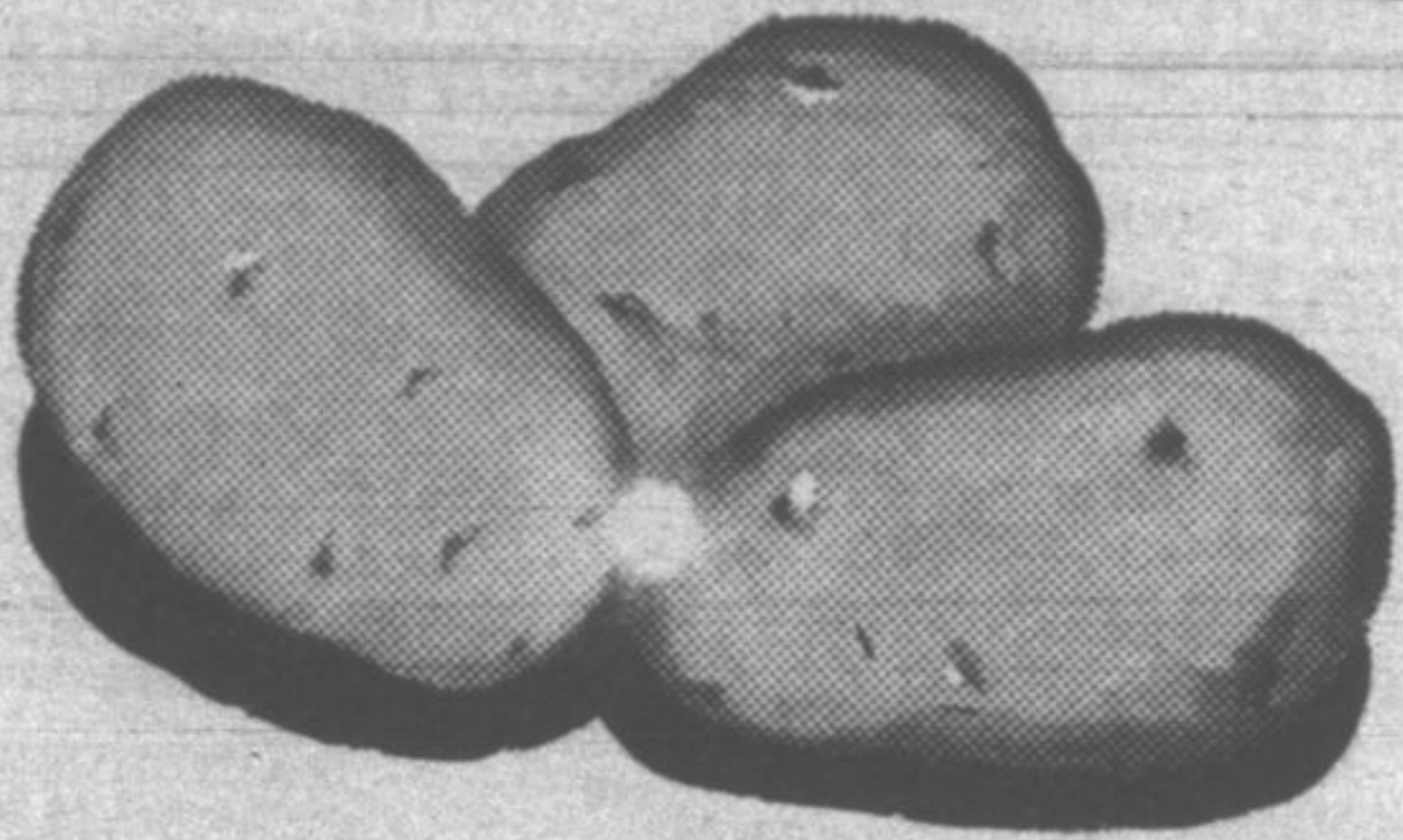
