April Temperatures and Precipitation

With a mean temperature of 46.7 degrees and only a little rainfall, April of this year was more agreeable on an average than the same month of 1930, the monthly report of John O. Laux indicates.

The maximum temperature was reached on April 13 when the mercury rose to 81 degrees and it dropped to 26 degrees on April 24 and 30.

Although the maximum temperature of April of last year was higher, 92 degrees, the mean temperature of 45 degrees was lower. April of both this and last year had 14 clear days. 11 days of the past month were party cloudy, and five were cloudy.

A precipitation of only 1.48 inches this year was low compared to a rainfall of 4.31 inches for the same month of 1930. Prevailing winds during April of both years were northeasterly.
