



#### BELIEVE HIGHWOOD BANK BANDIT CAUGH

Chicago Youth Held Secretly by City Police Since April 25th

Held secretly since April 25 under bonds of \$68,000, a Chicago youth charged with twice holding up the Highwood State bank, was late last week revealed in the role of a super bandit when it became known that State's Attorney A. V. Smith was making every effort to force him to trial in the circuit court.

The man, said to be Fred Berry, was arrested by Chicago police and charged with robbery, carrying concealed weapons and larceny of automobiles.

Issued Two Warrants

Through the Illinois Bankers' association employes of the Highwood bank were taken to Chicago where the identification of Berry was completed although he was surrounded by a crowd of prisoners, it is learned.

In an effort to bring Berry to Lake county Col. Smith signed two warrants, one charging robbery with a gun and the other charging attempted robbery, before Justice Harold Tallett.

The Highwood bank was held up December 31, 1929, when loot of \$10,-000 was taken by the lone bandit. Again in June, 1930, the same bandit appeared but was frustrated in his intentions by the explosion of tear gas which sent him reeling to the street after he had fired his revolver at employes.

Those in the bank who identified him in Chicago late in April were J. E. Engquist, cashier, and Ernie Lenzini, teller.

Description Fits

Walter Henderson, former chief of police in Highwood, admitted that the description given to him after the robberies fit perfectly with Berry.

All of the bank employes are positive of the identification because they saw the man twice.

Chief of Police William Peterson of Winnetka wants Berry for the robbery of the Hubbard Woods Trust and Savings bank where \$12,000 was taken.

State's Attorney John A. Swanson of Cook county is reluctant about releasing the man to Col. Smith because he believes, it is said, that they will find other cases in which he will be identified.

Swanson has promised Col. Smith, it is said, that he can have Berry if he is satisfied there will be a conviction in Lake county and if there are no other Cook county cases uncovered.

On the other hand Chief Peterson is eager to prosecute Berry for the Hubbard Woods robbery where he says Berry was the ringleader.

#### But Two Civil War Vets in Libertyville

Only two Civil War veterans will fall in line when the citizens of Libertyville march to the village cemetery on Memorial day to pay tribute to the community's honored dead.

E. S. Appley and Frank H. Doremus are the only surviving members of Libertyville Post G. A. R., which was organized in 1892 with an enrollment of 42 men. John Bullard was the post's first commander.

Hermance Wheeler, 88 years old, one of Libertyville's oldest citizens, is a Civil War veteran, but is a member of the Waukegan post and turns out with that organization each Decoration day.
