Interesting Exhibit of Sketches, Paintings

A very notable exhibit of sketches and paintings by Florence Crocker deBeers, Glencoe artist, is now hung in the living room and dining rooms of Glen Gables tea room, Glencoe. Most of the sketches were made during Mrs. deBeers' year in Paris, from which she has recently returned.

Charcoal portraits make up the major part of the small exhibit, and these show that the artist is thoroughly familiar with her medium, and is able to convey the personality of the model to the onlooker with arresting charm.

In her oils, Mrs. deBeers leans toward impressionism, respecting form yet subduing it and making it secondary to color. Light and shade are reflected through softly shaded colors. The exhibit will remain at the tea room for several weeks.

County Board Reduces Interest on Deposits

The interest rate on county funds on deposit in Lake county which was cut from 2 to 1 per cent by County Treasurer Jay B. Morse, May 1, was approved Monday by the county board of supervisors.

At the same time it was learned that the state of Illinois had taken a voluntary slash of 1½ per cent in interest on deposits throughout the state.

As banks pay 1 per cent for a depository bond to protect the money, the 1 per cent it pays in interest actually brings the cost of the deposit to 2 per cent to the bank, Supervisor Arthur W. Vercoe of Highland Park pointed out.
