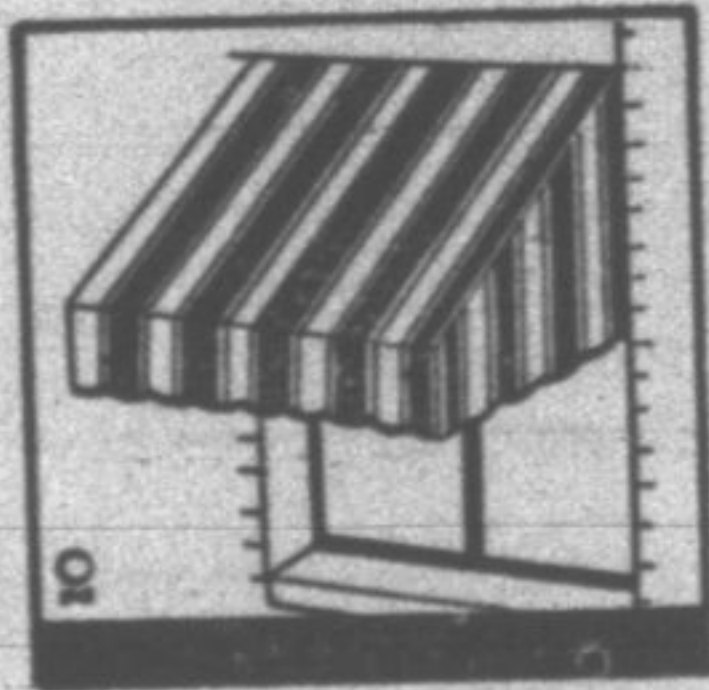

Lake Water Level Lowering Rapidly

The water level of Lake Michigan is rapidly coming down to the low stage of five years ago, according to the monthly report of the United States lake survey. The May level for every other year since 1860 has averaged .3 of a foot higher than the April level for the same year. The Lake Huron situation is the same.

In May those lakes were 1.85 feet lower than in 1930. .72 of a foot below the average May level for the past 10 years. The level was 4.40 feet below the high stage of May, 1886 and .96 of a foot above the low stage of May, 1926.

Lake Superior is falling less rapidly than the other lakes and in May was 1.65 feet above the low stage of May, 1926. The low level necessitates more work for the government dredgers, the taking of new soundings for navigation, and much harbor work.

Name Architect for Libertyville Masonic Temple to Be Erected

The committee in charge of building arrangements for the new Masonic temple to be erected at Libertyville has appointed John A. Schribbins, of Glencoe, architect for the proposed structure.

It is expected that detailed plans for the temple will be ready early in July and it is hoped that the contract can be let and work started before August 1.

Tentative plans call for a two-story building of English type, with rough stone front. It is estimated that building and furnishings will cost in the neighborhood of \$50,000.

The temple association recently purchased a lot at the corner of Brainard avenue and Church street as a site for the new structure.

Must Return Convict's Original Clothing When He Is Released, Ruling

No matter for how many years a convict is confined in a state prison the clothing that he exchanges for prison garb must be kept safely and returned to him on completion of his sentence, according to an opinion by Attorney General Oscar Carlstrom made public at Springfield.

The opinion was given in response to a request by Frank D. Whipp, state superintendent of prisons, who had asked whether it is mandatory to adhere to the letter of the law in cases of long term prisoners whose shoes and clothes deteriorate during many years of their "term."

The storage of the clothing requires considerable valuable space, according to Whipp, who pointed out that convicts are outfitted anew when released.

Carlstrom held that regardless of the length of term, the clothing and personal effects of the newly received prisoner must be kept safely and returned upon release.

Find Poison in Celery; Physician Urges That All Stalks Be Washed

Dr. Howard C. Hoag, retiring city physician, has warned Waukegan residents against eating celery until it had been washed thoroughly. His warning followed the discovery that a carload of celery received in Chicago, and distributed throughout the Chicago district, including Waukegan, contained a poisonous deposit.

The attention of Dr. Hoag was called to the situation when Mrs. Louis Marthel, 121 Fairview place, much perturbed, entered his office and exhibited a stalk of celery containing a pronounced green deposit which she feared was paris green. She had not discovered this until after some of the celery had been eaten. The stomach pump was used immediately to prevent possible serious results and the physician sent the celery to a laboratory for analysis.

The result of this analysis was that the green deposit was found to be copper sulphate, apparently sprayed on the celery while it was growing to kill insects.
