

### Summer Camp Season Opens at Ft. Sheridan; Dates for Groups Given

Approximately 3,400 men will receive training at the different summer camps at Fort Sheridan, which started its summer activities June 17. Military training for reserve units and civilians opened on that date, under Camp Commander Col. Edward Davis. The period will last until August 28.

Many North Shore youths will be among those men entering the R. O. T. C. training camp, which is open from June 19 until July 30. Units of four separate organizations will receive training.

In accordance with the custom of naming the post in honor of heroes who lost their lives in the World war, the camp will be named after George A. McKinlock, Jr., formerly of Lake Forest, while the streets of the camps will be named after other war heroes. Regular army organizations will give demonstrations during the training periods, illustrating phases of training. A demonstration platoon of cavalry, infantry, machine-gun, coast artillery, anti-aircraft, and field artillery will be maintained.

Enrollment in the C. M. T. C. camp is about 2,000; the O. R. C., 400; R. O. T. C., 40; and the National Guard, 600.

### Vets Hospital Patients to Have "Radio Pillows," Says War Dept. Statement

Every patient at the North Chicago veterans' hospital and the Great Lakes hospital is to have an individual radio, the war department announced last week, according to a report from Washington to the Waukegan Times.

"Radio pillows," small receivers encased in sponge rubber with an outlet to permit undisturbed reception, with individual volume control, will

be used by the department in furnishing radio entertainment to all patients in army hospitals. Programs will be distributed from a central receiving set in each hospital.

Installation will be made in 105 hospitals, with the Lake county institutions to be among the first to receive them.

By means of electrical cables to each bed, programs will be sent to the individual patient who will be provided with the high quality head sets.

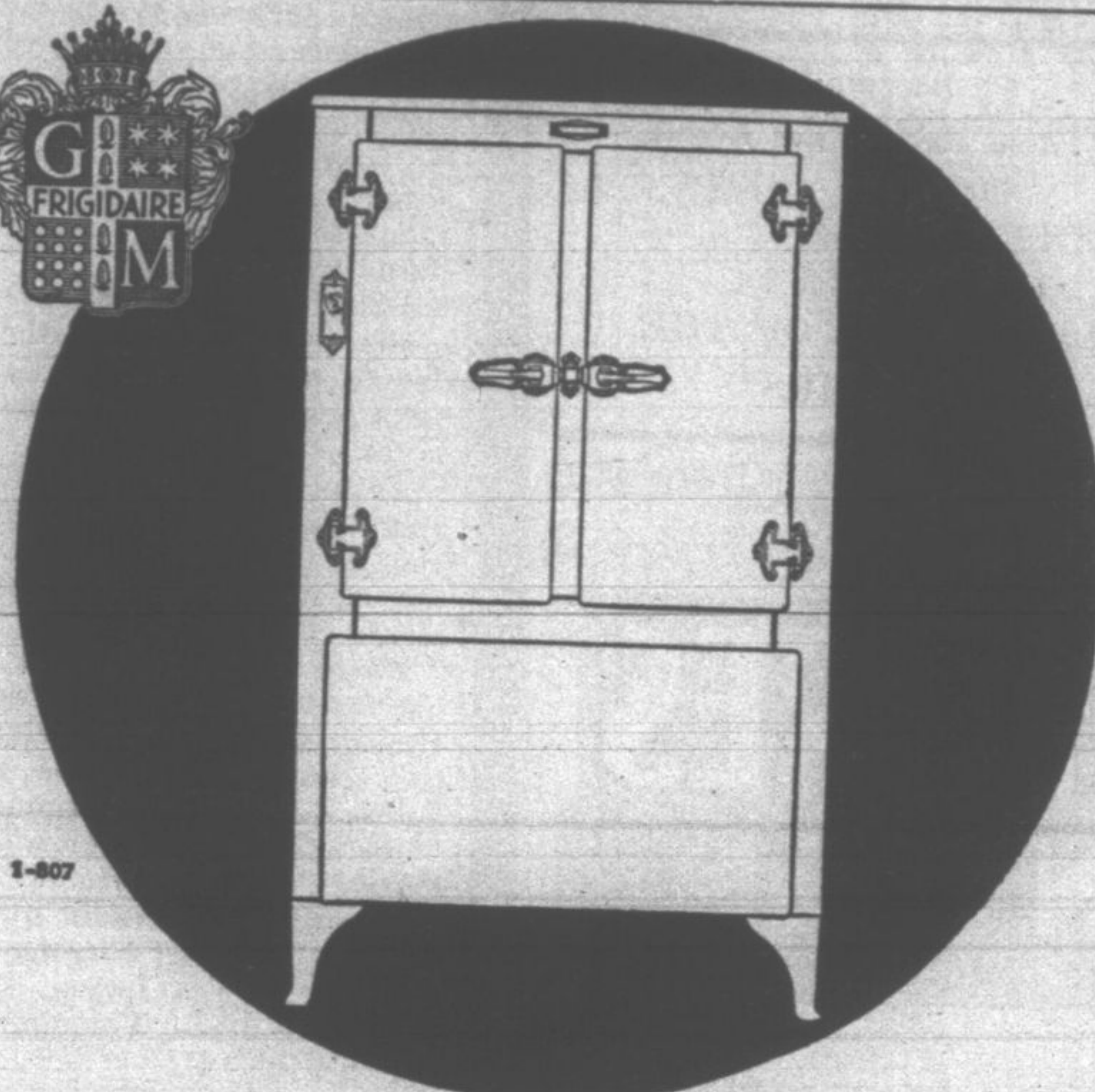
Need of such an installation has been recognized for years in veterans' hospitals. In many cases radios

have been installed in wards, which while entertaining the majority of patients have annoyed others.

Nearly 1,000 patients in the U. S. Veterans' hospital at North Chicago will enjoy the radio if their mental condition permits while practically all of the 800 patients in the Great Lakes hospital will benefit by the arrangement.
