

SIX PLAYGROUNDS TO BE OPENED JUNE 23

Although the program as planned is subject to change, the main features of it will be kept intact. The program that is presented here will be found helpful as a working indication of what the children will be doing at various times and hours, as follows:

- 9:00 to 9:30 a.m.—Free play.
- 9:30 to 10: a.m. — Group games, tumbling, group activities.
- 10 to 12 a.m.—Folk-dancing (Sunset park-Ravinia), preparation for tournaments, games, etc. at local playground.
- 1 to 2:30 p.m.—Free play and quiet games; story telling, nature study, handcraft, etc.
- 2:30 to 4—Playground activities, except Tuesday and Friday afternoons, when the children are taken to the beaches.
- 4 to 5—As above, with exceptions noted.

To Ravinia Park

Three afternoons a week are taken up, Tuesday and Friday at the beaches, when the children from all playgrounds are taken to the Park avenue and Roger Williams avenue beaches, and on Thursday afternoon all children are taken to Ravinia park, for the regular programs offered there. It is hoped that the evenings can be reserved, on each playground, for adult games, such as baseball, horseshoes, volleyball, and others. For the children, most of the instructional work and handicraft will be given in the forenoon, as the free afternoons are being kept open for trips and special events.

On Monday, July 6, the older children of the playgrounds will be taken to Sunset Valley to watch the fourth

annual North Shore Open tournament. Dress-Up day will be next Wednesday, June 24. All children are asked to come to the parks in costume, any sort of costume they can get hold of. Prizes will be offered for the most original and best costumes.

Work on Posters

During the first two weeks the girls of the various playgrounds will work on posters; the best of these will be exhibited around in the stores of Highland Park to tell about coming playground events.

One of the pleasant features of last season was the folk-dancing classes held at Sunset park every Tuesday and Thursday forenoon, from 10 to 12. These will be repeated this year, with Miss Cancie instructing in

tap-dancing, clogging, and specialty dances. There will also be classes in more elementary dancing for the younger girls.

On the excursions to the beaches the children will receive swimming instruction, either from members of the staff, or from the life-guard at the beach. Weenie-roasts and picnics will be features of the beach trips.

An entirely new feature this season is a story telling hour presented by Miss Ida M. Agress, the children's librarian at the public library. Miss Agress will be at the different playgrounds on separate mornings at 11 o'clock, and will spend an hour telling stories to interest children young and old.

Other Features

Other eventful features of the coming season will be a model boat and airplane contest, a trip to see the Chicago Cubs play, a trip to the lotus beds at Grass and Fox lakes, picnics and hikes, photography, the development of musical organizations, a Rodeo, and a Junior Olympics Track and Field meet.

The program has been carefully planned so as to give the greatest amount of pleasure and fun and educational value to the children of Highland Park. Parents have found before that their children are well taken care of, and it is the hope of the Park Board and the playground workers that this year will be the most successful so far.
