LAW CUTTING COUNTY BOARD IS CONFUSING

Lake Co. Members Puzzled as to How It Will Operate; Paddock's Measure

Though older members of the board of supervisors are reported reconciled to the new law signed by Gov. L. L. Emmerson which will reduce the board roll call by 12 members, they are confused as to what rules are to be followed in cutting the size of the board in 1933.

Under the law introduced by Senator Ray Paddock of Wauconda, the Lake county board will be cut from its present membership of 45 to 33, in April, 1933, says a Waukegan newspaper.

The board will then be composed of 18 supervisors from the 18 townships now in the county and 15 assistant supervisors.

Cut Waukegan List

Waukegan township which has 15 assistants in addition to Supervisor Matt P. Dilger, will only have 8 assistants starting in 1933. The confusion in Waukegan is that all the assistants whose terms expire in 1933 will be unable to seek office until 1935 unless some change is made in the present status of the board.

Waukegan township will only be entitled to eight assistants in 1933. Thus only the latter eight will hold office unless some new ruling is rendered.

The new law further provides that arrangements are to be made in each township for the election of its board

of supervisors so that half of its membership is to be elected every two years.

Further Tangle

Under this section, only four of the eight assistants would be entitled to continue holding office until 1935 while the other four, though elected last April to serve four years, would have to give up two years of their terms.

Under that stipulation the eight assistants holding four-year terms will have to reach an agreement as to who will continue the four-year terms. Only by this method, board members said, could an amicable agreement be reached.

Thus in 1933, though Waukegan will be entitled to only eight assistant supervisors, four of the present office holders will retain their posts until 1935, while four will be elected.

Shields and Deerfield

The same procedure, board members indicated, will have to be followed in Shields and Deerfield townships. Shields will lose two of its present assistants and Deerfield three in 1933.

Libertyville, and Zion townships will each retain their present supervisor and assistant. All the other townships each have a supervisor only.
