AIDS UNEMPLOYMENT

Illinois to Have 30,000 Men at Working on Roads During Present Year

Relief of unemployment is one the main objectives of the pushing of Illinois' greatest road building program that was ever attempted. Chief Highway Engineer Frank Sheets announced today.

Although the state does not directly hire the labor, the contracting companies that are handling the work are instructed to give preference in local people in hiring workers. In submitting bids on bridges and roads, the construction firms are expected to compute costs on a fair and reasonable wage scale and to pay on that basis.

Employ Over 30,000

A computation of the season's road employment situation that has just been completed in the highway division office, shows that more than 30,000 men will be employed directly and indirectly at road work this year. Including the men who are not engaged in the actual building of the Burglars Raid Three road, the employment figure is boosted to 30,314 men.
