### BRIEF NEWS ITEMS FROM LAKE COUNTY

#### Happenings About This Part of North Shore; County Seat Doings

Valuation of property in the town of Waukegan, excluding the property within the city limits of Waukegan, last week was set at \$5,016,535 by Assessor Russ Alford, who turned the books over to the board of review.

Mrs. Mary A. Miller, the widow of the late Robert N. Miller, passed away at her home, 1018 North Sheridan road, Waukegan, recently, at the age of 95 years.

Joan Adams, 19, of Chicago, lost the first joint of her right hand index finger when it was caught in the flywheel of a motorboat at Point Comfort, Fox Lake.

W. E. Webster, Libertyville realtor, was last week elected president of the Libertyville-Mundelein Chamber of Commerce for the ensuing year. R. F. Rouse was named vice-president, Roy A. Garbett, treasurer, and D. H. Holmes, was re-elected secretary.

A verdict of accidental death by returned by a coroner's jury under carbon monoxide gas poisoning was Dr. John L. Taylor following the inquest into the death of James H. Marseilles, 242 Gillette avenue, former city treasurer and city clerk of Waukegan.

Mrs. Jessie Ruse of near Libertyville, whose automobile struck and killed a neighbor's son, Edward Clift, last week, was cleared of all blame in connection with the tragedy by a coroner's jury.

Gustav Nelson, 64, attorney with offices at 140 North Dearborn street, Chicago, died suddenly at his summer home on Fox Lake, last week, and a coroner's inquest a few hours later found that death was due to heart ailment.

The name of Mancel Talcott, Waukegan postmaster, and an active participant in the endeavors of the American Legion, will be presented for the office of grand chef de gare of Illinois, by members of Lake County Voiture of the Forty and Eight, at the next state convention.

The first sign of relief in the banking tie-up in Waukegan, through the closing of two institutions, became apparent through the admission last week that the state auditors had completed their investigation of the Waukegan State bank and had sent the report to State Auditor Oscar Nelson.
