Seventy-five Hartz Mountain canaries, some valued at more than \$15, were warbling in trees in the vicinity

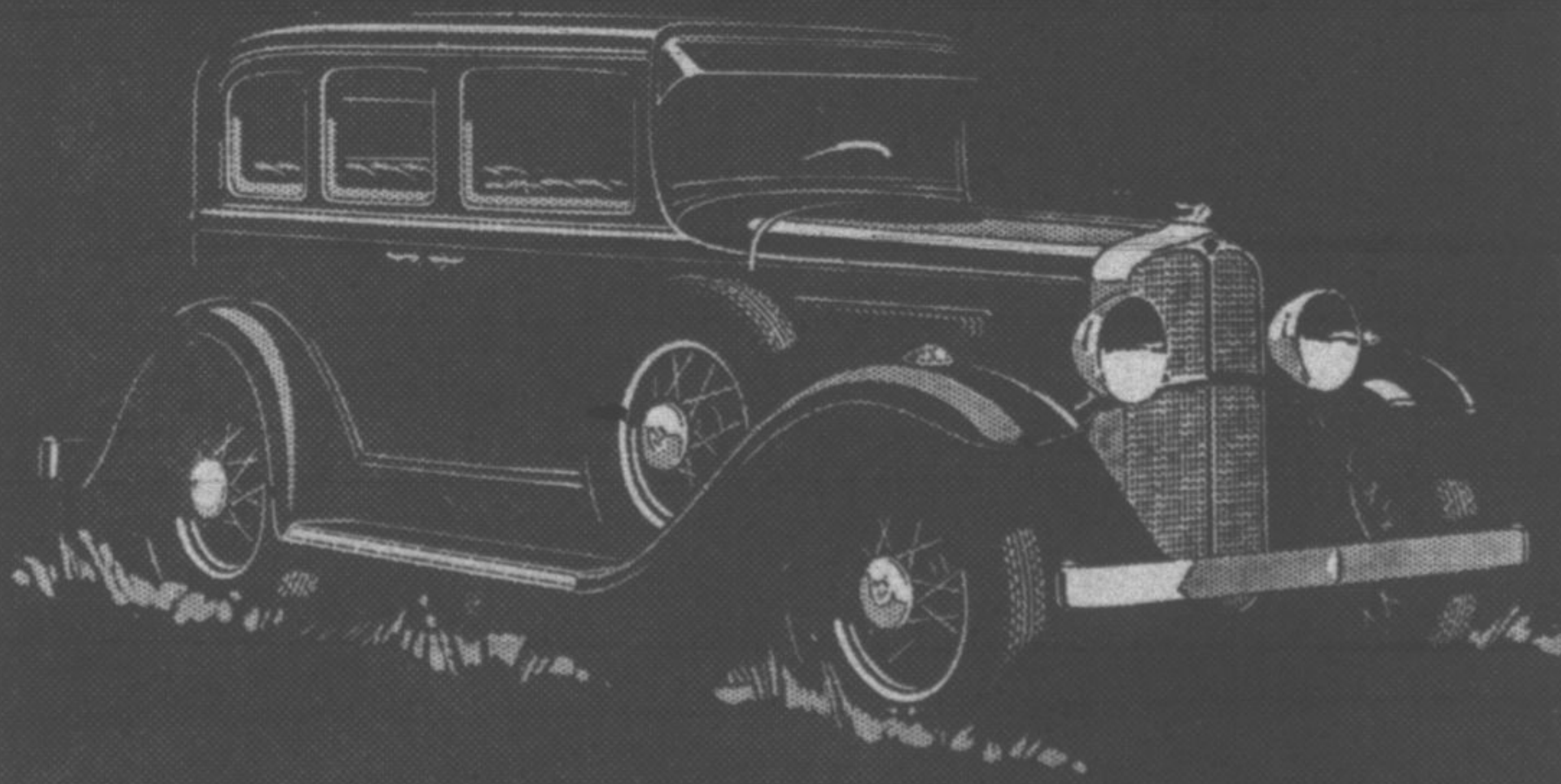
