on Wage Scale Not to Affect Lake Co. Work

The decision of a Circuit Judge of Sangamon county, that the prevailing wage scale law was unconstitutional, will not effect work in Lake county in the opinion of R. M. Lobdell, county superintendent of highways.

The legislature passed the law at the last session and it became effective July 1. The only contract to be awarded since then was the two mile paving job on the Mundelein-Buffalo Grove road which was let to the Myer's Construction company of Highland Park for approximately \$27,000.

"There is no injunction to prevent the work from being carried out, and in addition Myers, a union contractor, pays the salaries provided under the prevailing wage scale as set by the department," he pointed out.

Downstate counties protested to the prevailing wages in Lake, Cook, and Dupage counties because they believed this alleged high rate would react against the scales in their coun-

"As I see it, it is not whether the law is constitutional but whether a political body like the county can include a scale of wages in its construction contracts or if it is an invalid action," Lobdell said.

Sheriff Plans to Have Highways Patrolled in Winter Season, Report

The same county patrol of roads and villages that have no organized police forces, will be maintained through the winter months by Sheriff Lester Tiffany through his highway police, it is reported.

Tiffany plans to place his squads now on motorcycle duty on regular schedules through the fall and winter months to curb crime. He will have Deputy Sheriffs David A. Hutton, Geno. Palmieri, John DeSmidt, Arthur Grove and John Sweeney for these squads.

During the hunting season most of these men will draw assignments to protect farm lands from wanton trespassers.

The squads, under the present plans, will draw regular schedules weekly and will travel beats much as patrolmen. In this way the sheriff believes that the men can reach any point in the county within ten minutes after the report of a crime. The routes will be so arranged that the squads will be widely separated most of the time.
