U. S. Probing Smuggling of Aliens; Waukegan Is Among Ports Scrutinized

Probe of activities of alien smugglers will be extended to Waukegan by federal operatives who started their investigations in the Great Lakes district when they arrived in Chicago from Washington last week.

The presence of a harbor, several miles of water front and the existence of a large foreign population in Waukegan and North Chicago has signaled the two cities out as one of the probable terminals in the activities of a gigantic smuggling ring that has had an income from \$50 to a \$100,000,000 annually.

Waukegan has also aroused the interest of the investigators by reason of the fact that several round-ups of aliens who have entered this country without permission have been made here within the past year or more.

According to Murray W. Garsson, special assistant secretary of labor, and W. Frank Watkins, supervisor of the investigating force, there is an established price list for the racketeers' service in getting aliens over the borders, the quotations ranging from \$200 to \$6,000 per man, in addition to ordinary transportation costs.
