

Tuberculosis Assn. in County Cuts Expenses; Release Oral Hygienist

With expenses curtailed to a minimum that barely permits operation, the Lake County Tuberculosis association through a limited personnel, is laying plans in an effort to carry through for the year.

To keep within its depleted budget, that has been caused by growing demands for aid due to the economic conditions, the executive committee was forced last night to release its Rural hygienist, ponder over the problem of keeping a secretary, and have the state carry the payroll expense of the nurse who serves as executive secretary. Expenses \$9,000

Expenditures last year amounted to approximately \$9,000 which covered payroll, maintenance, clinics, school examinations, and hospitalization.

Every phase of the work will have to be curtailed, and possibly aban-

doned entirely, except the clinics for tuberculars and tubercular suspects, according to Miss Hendrickson, the nurse assigned here by the state.

The state will meet the payroll for Miss Hendrickson until Jan. 1, when the association hopes through its seals sale to replenish the stripped bank account.

To Continue Clinics

The association will not give up its clinics as this is believed to be the most effective work, but there is some fear that if conditions do not improve that work will have to be suspended entirely.

The situation extends beyond the county, it is understood, as Lake county usually receives more revenue from the Christmas seal sale than any other county. The state has been forced to help other sections even in better times.

Sullivan Seeking Parole; in Prison Over Woman's Death

George Sullivan, Highland Park man serving a 15 year sentence in Joliet penitentiary for murder, is seeking audience before the state pardon board to ask for pardon or commutation of sentence, according to word received by State's Attorney A. V. Smith.

Sullivan, who is between 35 and 40 years old, was convicted in Lake county court three years ago for the slaying of Mrs. J. E. McGrath, wife of a Highwood railroad man.

Following conviction the sentence was imposed by Circuit Judge Claire C. Edwards, and Sullivan was committed to Joliet.

So far as known to the state's attorney, the petition of which he received notice is the first attempt of Sullivan at pardon or commutation.

The petition of Sullivan is scheduled for hearing by the pardon

board in a meeting to be held this month. The notice came from George H. Brown, Springfield, state parole officer.

What action will be taken by the prosecutor's office on the petition and hearing was not indicated.

Plan to Observe Navy Day at Great Lakes
