### BERNARD GROSS IS KILLED IN CRASH

H. P. Youth Victim of Auto Accident at Lake Bluff; Companion Badly Hurt

Bernard Gross, 28, of Highland Park, fatally injured in a collision on Sheridan road, north of Lake Bluff, died en route to the Alice Home hospital in Lake Forest Saturday night.

Gross' car, driven by Frank Tentas, 22, also of Highland Park, crashed into a Kennedy garage tow truck north of Lake Bluff, and then struck the southbound car of Dr. A. G. Hopkins of Chicago. Occupants of the doctor's car escaped with slight bruises although the car was wrecked.

Gross, thrown against the windshield, was knocked unconscious. and Tentas, the driver, was also badly hurt. Both were taken to the Lake Forest hospital, but Gross died en route.

Chief Sees Crash

Police Chief Eugene Spaid of Lake Bluff, directing traffic while the tow truck was dragging another wrecked car away, saw the accident. He declared that Tentas was driving north at a high rate of speed, and that he attempted to signal to them with a flashlight. The car swerved and crashed into the tow truck, parked alongside the paving.

Gross and Tentas were removed from the wreckage. A third youth Neale Walsh of Highland Park, riding with them, suffered less serious injures.

Acting Coroner Maurice J. Penney swore in a jury Sunday, but continued the inquest in order to allow Tentas to testify. Tentas was expected to remain in the Lake Forest hospital for several days. His back was injured, it was reported.
