### SUPREME COURT IN RECENT GRIM RECORD

#### Refuses to Interfere in Death Sentences of Several Murderers, Report

The old maxim "Crime does not pay," is well borne out by the record of cases in the Illinois Supreme court, which adjourned from its October term last week.

Since October 6, when the court convened, five men have been executed in the Cook county jail, one died at Chester, one was saved only by a last minute stay allowing him a sanity hearing, and another is to die at Chester in December, according to a decision of the court handed down yesterday.

#### Four Are Electrocuted

On October 19, four men were electrocuted after being denied court intervention and clemency from the governor. They were John Popescu and Charles Rocco, who were convicted of killing Courtney Merrill, October 23, 1930; Richard Sullivan who with Frank Bell had been sentenced to die for the killing of Christ Patras in June, 1930, Bell being allowed a rerieve for a sanity hearing; and Frank Jordan, who had killed Anthony Ruthy, a Chicago policeman who had been a witness in the Alfred Lingle murder case. A week before the four men went to the chair, John Preston, the "model husband," had paid the supreme penalty for the murder of Agnes Johnston, a stenographer.

#### First at Chester

On October 20, Murley Johnson was sent to the chair for the killing of Mrs. Carrie Bowers and her two little sons near Mattoon last summer. Johnson, who made no attempt to escape the "chair," was the first person to be executed by electrocution at Chester.

By the court's decree yesterday, Hazel Johnson, negro, will die at Chester for the murder of William D. Keller at Decatur last January. Johnson dies December 11, unless clemency is extended by Governor Louis L. Emmerson.
