Plans of State to Improve Rt. 42 Thru Fort Sheridan Are Involved

With the state preparing to pave two and a half miles of Sheridan road through the military reservation, the routing through Highland Park remains undetermined. A controversy over the routing has ensued.

Last week the Chamber of Commerce presented a petition urging that the vacation of Sheridan road through the Wright property be set aside. It is contended that the vacatin was illegal, and that the roadway, if retained, will provide the best right of way.

The state has offered to widen and maintain a route through the city if a straight right of way is provided in the northern part of the city, and the city council will probably act on the matter. Fort Sheridan Work

The Fort Sheridan work will be two and a half miles through the military reservation. The federal government has ceded the right of way for the project to the state, which has agreed to pave and maintain the highway.

Routes 41 and 42 will be relocated, so that cross traffic will be eliminated on the reservation. Sheridan road will enter the post at the southeast corner, and will proceed in a northerly direction to the north shore yards.

The city of Lake Forest has asked that the highway be rerouted so that through traffic would be carried on McKinley avenue as far north as the Jones place, and then turned back to Sheridan road.

The state has agreed to that change and will widen the road this year if funds permit, it was anneunced.
