### Community Service Grid Tourney Finals; Winners Are Listed

The finals, in the first annual Football Tournament sponsored by Community Service of Highland Park, Inc., were held Friday, November 6, at Sunset park.

Prior to the final meet, elimination contests had been held at the various grammar schools to determine their representatives in the finals. About 165 boys between the ages of 9 and 15 years, punted, passed, and drop-kicked for the three qualifying places in the five age divisions.

The competition was very spirited, and owing to the large number of boys who competed, distances made in the three events were very good.

The tournament was conducted on a point system whereby points were awarded the contestant according to his age and distance made in the event. Chester Skidmore of Elm Place school proved to be the class of the field by amassing a total of 2224 points, over 300 points above his nearest competitor.

With this event becoming an annual occurrence, who knows but what Highland Park may in future years point with pride to several All-Americans.
