## Drafting Changes in New Field House for Deerfield-Shields

Changes in the plans for the new Deerfield-Shields high school field house, to be built on the athletic field, are being drafted by the architects, Perkins, Chatten and Hammon. The changes were made necessary to keep the cost of the field house within the \$65,000 limit set by the board of education. The original plans being rejected because of the cost, necessitated the reduction in the seating capacity from 5,000 to 3,000. The new overall length of the building will be 300 by 236.

A new feature to be included in the field house will be a "run around" shower in the girls' gymnasium, which was commented on last week by Prof. Odell of the University of Illinois. Prof. Odell also showed great interest in the development of the library and dividing walls.
