## N. S. GAS CO. PLANS TO REDUCE RATES



Those who will benefit from the rate reduction are those using gas for domestic gas appliances, and customers whose homes are heated with gas. All gas used in domestic applicances will be charged for at a rate two per cent less than the old rate; while all gas burned in gas home heating plants will cost 10 per cent less than it has in the

The new rates the North Shore Gas company has devised, it is pointed out, are based on the production and distribution costs of manufactured gas. There will be no change in the quality or kind of gas the company is serving, Mr. Hart declares.
