

N. S. GAS CO. PLANS TO REDUCE RATES

Following sanction by the municipalities affected, the new rates will be filed with the Illinois Commerce Commission for final approval, according to J. G. Hart, general manager for the gas company in Waukegan.

Those who will benefit from the rate reduction are those using gas for domestic gas appliances, and customers whose homes are heated with gas. All gas used in domestic appliances will be charged for at a rate two per cent less than the old rate; while all gas burned in gas home heating plants will cost 10 per cent less than it has in the past.

The new rates the North Shore Gas company has devised, it is pointed out, are based on the production and distribution costs of manufactured gas. There will be no change in the quality or kind of gas the company is serving, Mr. Hart declares.

HANS HESS, CELLIST, IN RECITAL

the request of Lake Forest that McKinley road be used for the state highway through the south tip of the city. As now planned, it will enter Fort Sheridan at the southeast corner and proceed diagonally northwest to the intersection with McKinley road.

To Widen Road

If funds permit this year, the latter thoroughfare will be widened to forty feet by the state, and routes 42 and 41 carried as far north as Jones place, which will be paved to divert traffic back to Sheridan road. It may be necessary to postpone this part of the improvement until next year.
