The attitude of Waukegan residents regarding erection of the proposed new \$735,000 sewage disposal plant here will be considered by the city council before any agreement is entered into with the sanitary district for construction of the system.

Demurrer in behalf of Fred Brown Whitney, receiver of the Waukegan State bank, in the suit of the city of Waukegan to recover \$150,000 in tax anticipation warrants held by the bank was overruled by Circuit Judge Edward Shurtleff.

Mrs. Eva Anna Keller, aged 63, mother of former Commissioner Nicholas M. Keller of Waukegan, died last week at her home, 1530 Dugdale road, North Chicago.

Salary and wage slashes, ranging from 7½ to 15 per cent for all executives, members of the supervisory forces and clerks on the Chicago North Shore and Milwaukee railroad, were announced November 14 as effective immediately, according to Waukegan newspapers.

The 143 teachers of the Waukegan city schools face decided reductions in salary next spring due to curtailed income, according to a statement made by John E. Reardon, secretary of the board of education.

Staple thieves stole a double set of harness from the Meyers Brothers' farm at Fremont Center, Chief of Police Clayton Tiffany of Mundelein reported to the sheriff's office.
