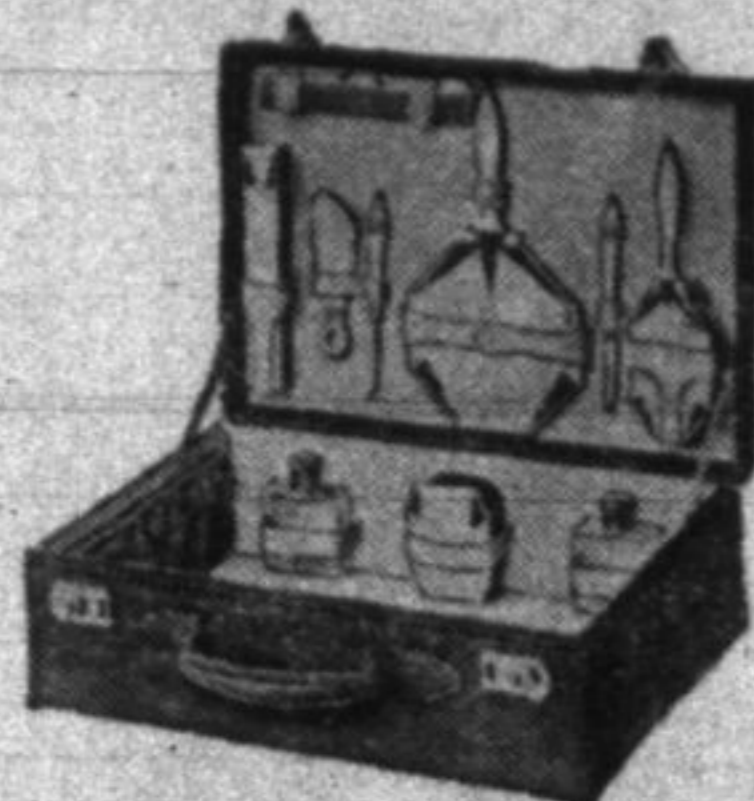

EXTENSIVE PAVING
PLAN FOR COUNTY

Lobdell Tells Prospects for
Increase of Hard Roads
in Future

Hundreds of laborers, unemployed because of the invalid wage laws for road building, will be given work next year and in years to come in Lake county if the county highway projects contemplated for the near future, as outlined by Supt. of Highways R. M. Lobdell last week to the Lake County Engineers association, are fully carried out.

A program of road building which will make the county a haven for motorists, was pictured by Lobdell. Relief for the unemployed will come first, if the plans are carried out as proposed.

Plan 90 Miles of Paving

Lake county with its 250 miles of paved and gravel roads will be extended to 340 miles in the next few years. The present plans call for 90 miles more of good roads to be constructed by the state and county governments.

The road building program will mean the expenditure of millions of dollars. Laborers in Lake county will get the greater portion of these funds if the understanding now existing between Lobdell, the road and bridge committee of the board of supervisors and contractors are continued.

Following a conference with state highway department officials at Springfield, Lobdell and members of the road and bridge committee were optimistic of the contemplated highway projects. The state refund on gasoline taxes has averaged \$185,000 a year. This money is used for the maintenance and upkeep of roads.

Fund to Increase

With the increase of better and more roads in Lake county, the gas refund will increase, it was said.

The long battle over right-of-way for route 173, between Rockford and Zion, has held back that project. But at present the greater portion of the highway in Lake county is either under construction or is under contract.

Naval Station Will
Contribute to Relief

Emergency relief contributions estimated at between \$5,000 and \$10,000 are to be made by officers, enlisted men, and civilian employees of the Great Lakes Naval Training station in keeping with a suggestion by Secretary of the Navy Charles Francis Adams, according to information released by Rear Admiral commandant.

The plan will undoubtedly be followed out at Great Lakes as well as all other naval stations in the country," Admiral Crosley stated today.

"Although we have only the bare details of the plan, it appears that about 1,000 Great Lakes people will contribute to the extent of three days pay to their salaries. It is impossible to estimate accurately just what the aggregate total contribution will be," the commandant added.
