Four children of John Dean Purdy, Jr., member of a pioneer Highland Park family, and three other relatives will share the estate of more than \$275,000, according to a petition for the probate of the will of Purdy, who died November 7, 1931, filed this week with Probate Clerk John R. Bullock.

John Dean Purdy III, 108 North Sheridan road, Highland Park; Dorothy P. Kimball, Hinsdale, and Virginia P. Jordan and Gwendolyn P. Johnston of Los Mochis, Mexico, are the four children who will share in the estate. Three other legatees are named in the petition, which was set for hearing before Judge Martin C. Decker on January 4, 1932.

Edward M. Laing, Supt. of the East Park board of Highland Park, left an estate of \$2,000, according to the petition for the probate of his will. His wife is named as the legatee.
