## Lake Co. Is Fifth in Fees Paid For Automobile License

Lake county attained fifth rank among downstate counties of the state for the total of automobile license fees paid to the state. Lake county automobile owners paid a total of \$351,416.

St. Clair county led all other counties with the exception of Cook county for the amount paid, this county turning in \$389,239 into the state treasury last year.

Peoria county was second with \$382,560; Kane third with \$373,972; Winnebago fourth with \$359,448, and Madison county trailed Lake county for sixth place with \$347,122. The sum of \$125,586 was collected in McHenry county.

Cook county paid \$8,542,415 or almost half of the total collected from the entire state.
