Lake county attained fifth rank among downstate counties of the state for the total of automobile license fees paid to the state. Lake county automobile owners paid a total of \$351,416.

St. Clair county led all other counties with the exception of Cook county for the amount paid, this county turning in \$389,239 into the state treasury last year.

Peoria county was second with \$382,560; Kane third with \$373,972; Winnebago fourth with \$359,448, and Madison county trailed Lake county for sixth place with \$347,-122. The sum of \$125,586 was collected in McHenry county.

Cook county paid \$8,542,415 or almost half of the total collected Henry G. Winter from the entire state.
