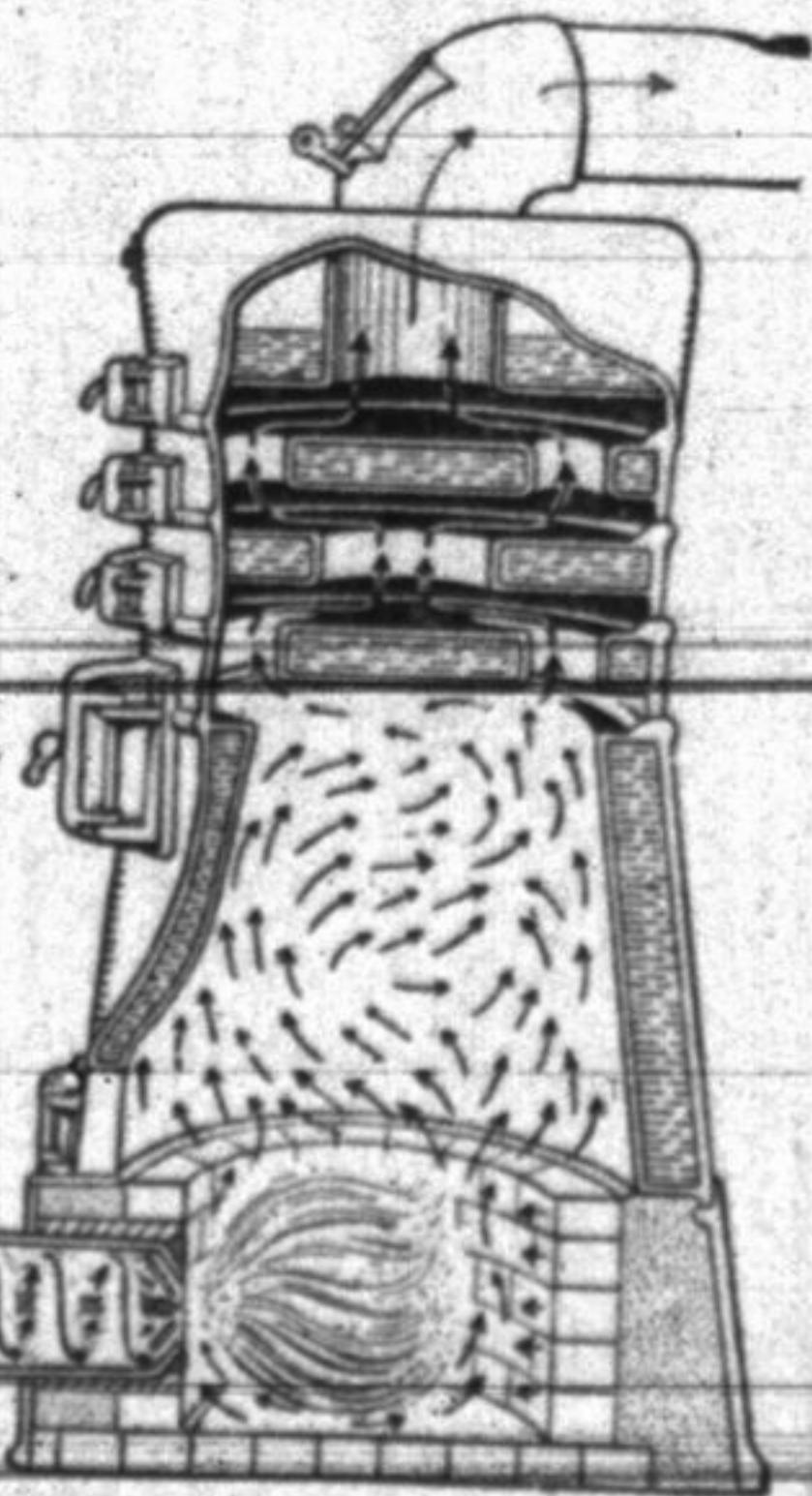

**Lake Co. Residents  
Named on Governor's  
Relief Committee**

Three county residents and two rural district bankers were named on the committee of seven administrators of the unemployment relief fund, it was reported last week.

Joseph M. Cudahy of 830 North Green Bay road, Lake Forest, the Chicago packer, and Samuel Insull Jr., of Libertyville, who was chairman of the \$10,500,000 relief fund drive for Cook county, and Col. A. A. Sprague of Lake Forest, are the three named on the committee by Gov. L. L. Emmerson.

Other members of the committee are Omar H. Wright, Belvidere banker; Arthur Eidman, Belleville banker; Edward L. Ryerson Jr., president of the Joint Emergency Relief fund of Cook county, and Victor A. Olander, secretary of the Illinois Federation of Labor.

The drive to sell \$18,500,000 state tax anticipation warrants for use by the Illinois Emergency Relief committee, as authorized by the legislature, will start tomorrow afternoon following two luncheons of bankers and bond house officials.

"No plans have been made for a drive similar to the Liberty Loan drives," Frank M. Gordon, vice-president of the National Bank of Chicago, stated. "We do not believe that a special drive will be necessary and look for an immediate oversubscription. We are aiming particularly at the money hoarded in safe deposit boxes and feel that there is no other security on the market right now that has the same return and the same safety. A security paying 6 per cent and with the entire state behind it should appeal to every investor."

Mr. Gordon and Frank McNair, vice president of the Harris Trust and Savings bank, will be in joint charge of the drive.

**IMPORTANT DATES  
OCCUR IN FEBRUARY**

**Birth Anniversary of Noted Men; Church Holiday; Also Leap Year Month**

February is a month filled with holidays, anniversaries, and dates recalling memorable events. This year has the attraction of an extra day, for the 29-day second month of 1932 makes this a leap year, and gives those who were born on Feb. 29 their first birthday in four years.

First in prominence when February is considered this year is Washington's birthday, Monday, Feb. 22, which because of the fact that George Washington was born in 1732 will be celebrated all over the country as the bicentennial anniversary.

**Other Birthdays**

The birthdays of three other famous men also fall within the limits of this month. Col. Charles Lindbergh was born Feb. 4, 1902, and was 30 years old on that day. Thomas A. Edison was born Feb. 11, 1847, and his birthday anniversary is just a week after Lindbergh's. And Abraham Lincoln's birthday was recalled on Friday, Feb. 12. Lincoln was born in 1809. Tuesday, Feb. 2, was Ground hog or Candlemas day. St. Valentine's day, Feb. 14, next in line was on a Sunday this year, the second Sunday of the month.

Another day of significance during the month was Ash Wednesday, Feb. 10, which marks the beginning of the Lenten season, and various degrees of fasting and abstinence for the religiously inclined.

**Death of Wilson**

Wednesday, Feb. 3, was the anniversary of the death of Woodrow Wilson, who died in 1924; Monday, Feb. 15, the anniversary of the destruction of the battleship Maine, in 1898; Wednesday, Feb. 17, the anniversary of the adoption of the Banyan tree seal in 1863, and Sunday, Feb. 28, is the anniversary of the first railroad charter in the United States. This was granted to the B. and O. railroad in 1827.

February's full moon will be on Sunday, the 21st. The new moon was Saturday, Feb. 6th, the first quarter Sunday, Feb. 14, and the last quarter is on Sunday, Feb. 28.

Feb. 29, which falls on Monday and is a day coming only once every four years, will bring birthdays to large numbers of persons who have not had a real birthday anniversary since Feb., 1928. This is the day that gives to 1932 the quality of being Leap Year, during which women supposedly have the right to propose to men.
