CAN'T SELL GAS

Attorney General Holds That This Selling Scheme Not Legal

Gasoline must be sold by the gallon and not by the dollar and cent plan of the "Elgin system," Attorney General Oscar Carlstrom ruled last week. The Elgin system was declared to be in violation of the state weights and measures law by the Attorney General in an opinion given by W. T. Fossett, state superintendent of standards.

"Under the Elgin system," Mr. Fossett told the attorney general, gasoline is sold by dollars and cents rather than by measure, that is, with gasoline at 17.4 cents per gallon, 5 and 16-20th gallons must be sold for \$1.00.

Dimeult to Test

The superintendent pointed out that it would be difficult to test gasoline pumps or to definitely estimate the gasoline tax due, where the "Elgin system" was used.

Attorney General Carlstrom advised him that provisions of state law make it unlawful to sell gasoline except by the standard gallon.

"Any other standard for the sale of gasoline than the standard gallon is made unlawful," the opinion said, "and any other division of the gallon except into halves, quarters, eighths, sixteenths, and thirty-seconds for the sale of gasoline is likewise prohibited by statute.

"The Elgin system chart provides a method for setting the movable price markers along a standard on the visible glass bowl on a gasoline pump according to the variation in the price of gasoline, the gallon to be divided into twentieths for the purpose of setting the movable price markers.

Violates Law

"It is my opinion, therefore, in response to your inquiry that since the Elgin system chart provides a method of sale of gasoline by dividing the standard gallon into twentieths, that this chart is violative of the provisions of the weights and measures law of this state."
