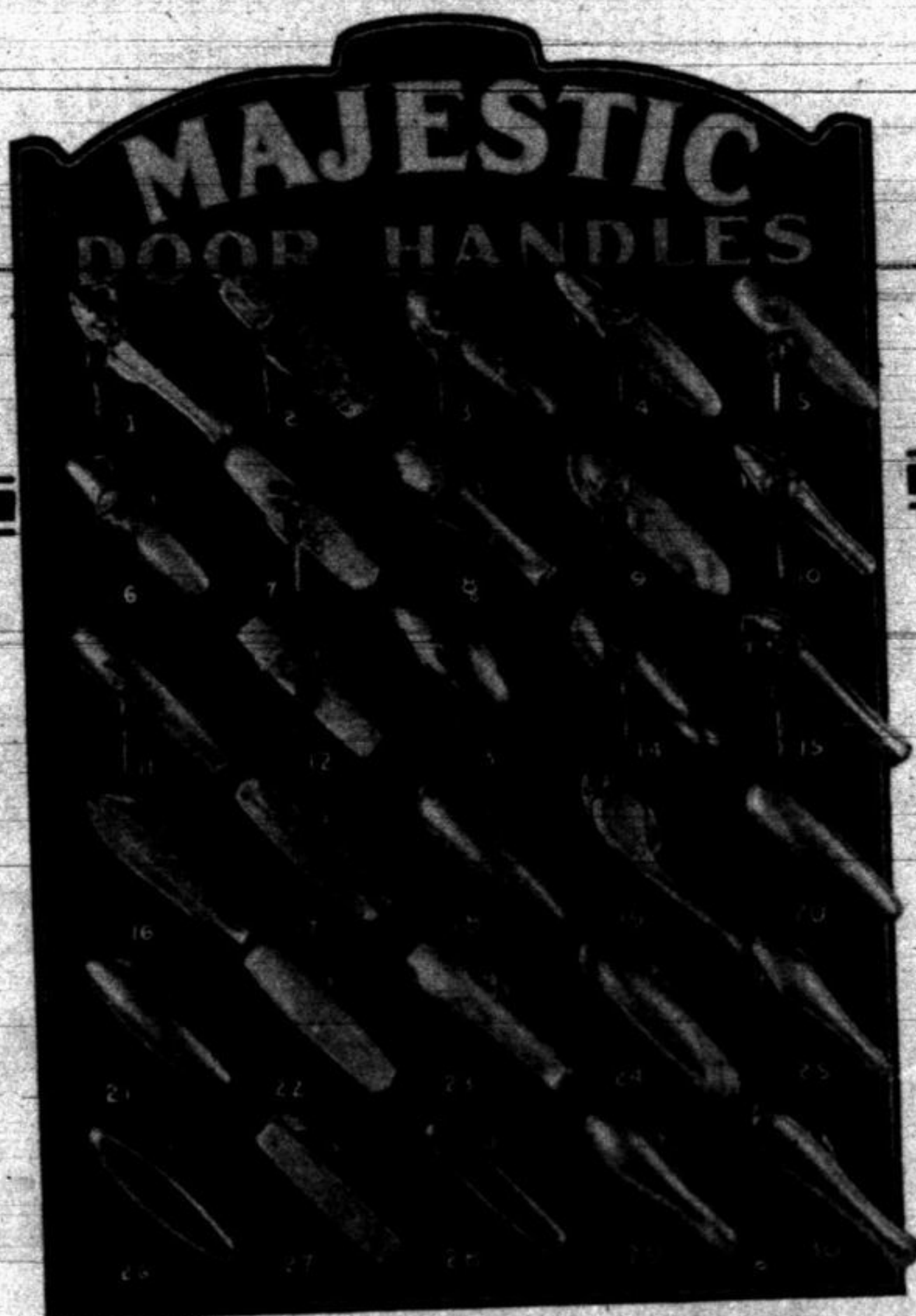

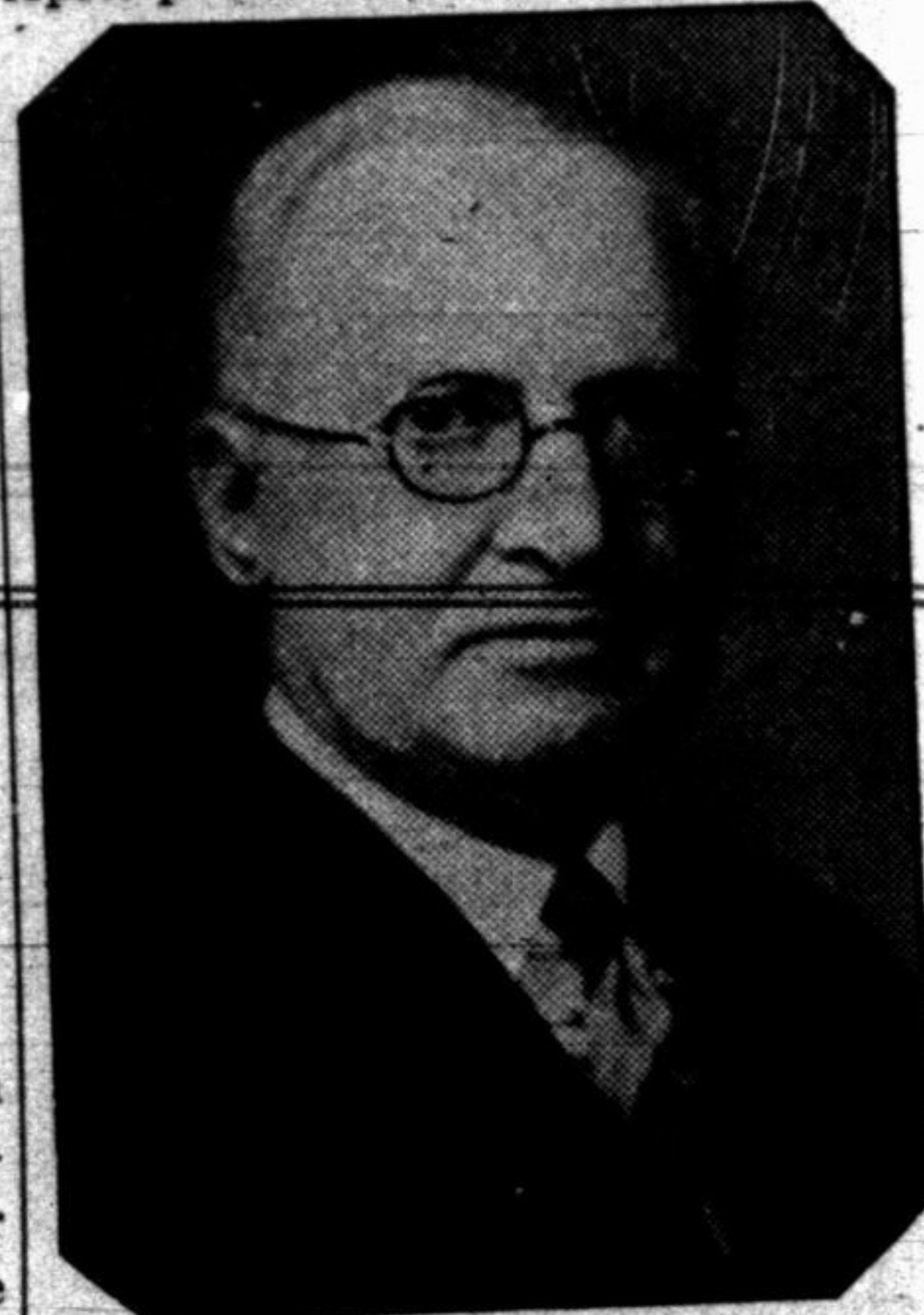

**Coroner Taylor Is
Candidate Again for
Nomination; Career**

Dr. John L. Taylor, of Libertyville, who has filled the office of county coroner for the past thirty-one years, this week announced his candidacy for re-election as a regular Republican candidate in the April primaries.

Efficiency and economy have marked Dr. Taylor's many years as coroner.

That Lake county has been fortunate in having a man of his calibre fill the office is the opinion of most of its citizens.

Dr. Taylor was first elected to office in the year 1900. Nominations in those days were made at caucuses, attended by delegates from the various townships and campaigning was carried on by horse and buggy. He was successful in being nominated that year over four other candidates.

Since his first term, Dr. Taylor has been returned again and again by the voters, who have placed their confidence in him for the efficient and economic operation of the office. In point of years, Dr. Taylor is one of the two oldest county officers, in that respect only by L. O. Brockway, recorder of Lake county.

The office of county coroner has always been established at Libertyville, where Dr. Taylor has made his home. He is not only well known in Libertyville, where he has a host of close friends, but he is equally well known all over the county.

An examination of the records of the coroner's office, as kept by Dr. Taylor during his eight terms in office, will convince one that the office has been handled efficiently, economically and honestly. As required by law, a detailed and complete record has been kept of every case handled. Records on cases 30 years old are as easily obtainable as cases handled last week.
