A. & P. Stores Sales for Four Weeks Is Reported; Is Decrease

drawn.

Sales of the Great Atlantic & Pacific Tea company for the four week period ending February 27th were \$69,860,876. This compares with \$82,441,242 for the same period in 1931, and is a decrease of \$12,-580,366, or 15.26 per cent.

February sales, expressed in tons, were estimated as 412,767 this year, compared with 439,545 in February, 1931. This is a decrease in quantity of merchandise sold of 26,-778 tons or 6.09 per cent.

Average weekly sales in February were \$17,465,219, compared with \$20,610,311 in 1931, a decrease of \$3,145,092. Average weekly tonnage sales were 103,192 compared with 109,886 in February 1931, a decrease of 6,64.

Total sales for the fiscal year ending February 27, 1932, are estimated at \$1,008,000,000 as compared with \$1,065,806,885 for the year ending February 28, 1931, a decrease of 5.41 per cent.
