### N. Shore Art League Is Offering Class in Art Criticism During April

There are really two parties to any work of art: the artist who creates it, and the spectator who looks at it or listens to it and finally judges it. It is in sympathy with the trials of the spectator that the North Shore Art League is now offering—in addition to classes in drawing, painting and design, a class in Art Criticism in the new studio in the Community House at Winnetka.

Miss Elizabeth Wilder will give a series of six lectures, an introductory treatment of the subject, in order that it may have its place from the beginning in the activities at the studio. The classes will deal with the perennial questions which present themselves when we look at a piece of art: Is it art? and what is art? what are the characteristics of a thing which may be called beautiful? Have we any right to demand that art be true to reality? Has art any debt to morality? These and many others are problems which one cannot pretend to solve in the course of six afternoons; but one can discuss them, compare the theories of the great thinkers of the past, and consider art from the different points of view which they suggest.

The lectures, which will extend through April, will sometimes be illustrated; they will include discussion, and suggestions for reading and study. Miss Wilder has specialized in the study of aesthetics in relation to the history of art, at Smith college and in Europe. This is an opportunity for studying art and the principles which underly it, such as one seldom finds without a journey to the city. Anyone interested in the class is cordially invited to attend the first meeting, which will be held the Tuesday after Easter, March 29, at three o'clock, at the studio in the Community House at Winnetka. The lengthening of the Sunset Valley eighteen to more than 6500 yards gives it the yardage required for championship play, and the careful placing of hazards and the remarkable character of the natural difficulties present on the course make it a real test of golf. Every resident of Highland Park more than twelve years of age is eligible to membership in the Sunset Valley golf club, and to play on this fine course at a ridiculously low fee.

Interest in tournament play should be keener than ever this year, and a number of special events for men and women are highly attractive.

Reduction in the caddy fee by placing it on the basis of a round rather than on a fixed charge per hour is another important improvement in the general policy of the club. Sunset Valley has reason to be proud of its caddies, all of them residents of Highland Park. A caddy master will give his entire time to training the boys.

Parents who have learned of the plan of group instruction for children have expressed themselves as highly pleased with the idea. Tom Kelly, professional and club manager, has had unusual success with his young charges, and some surprises may be expected in the children's tournament which will be organized during the season. There will also be instruction groups for adults which will bring the cost of lessons down to a very low fee.

Plans to improve the restaurant service and to make the club dining room attractive to non-golfers as well as those who frequent the course call for the serving of table d'hote lunches and dinners as a minimum cost.
