

## LOBDELL URGES ROAD WIDENING THRU FORT

Sheridan road over Jones place, a short piece of road, a short distance south of Sacred Heart seminary, he believes that the State will be willing to proceed with the improvement as planned, regardless of the action of the Lake Forest council.

### Points Out Advantages

The letter urges Mrs. McCormick, whose land borders McKinley and Sheridan roads alike and lies on both sides of Jones place, to dedicate a strip sufficient to widen Jones place as planned and points out that by so doing traffic on Sheridan road, which now passed through the middle of this tract owned by Mrs. McCormick, will be diverted to the west side of said tract, which, he understands, the owner has long desired.

The letter to Mrs. McCormick was written after receipt by Lobdell of a letter from the acting city clerk of Lake Forest reciting the action taken on the Sheridan road improvement by the Lake Forest city council.

Improvement of Sheridan road through Fort Sheridan is greatly desired by Highland Park and other motorists who must necessarily use this highway in driving north and south along the shore, and it is hoped that notwithstanding the apparent disinclination of the Lake Forest authorities to facilitate the plan of the state in the premises, a solution of the difficulty may be reached through the medium of his suggestions in the letter to Mrs. McCormick.


