### New Sewage Plant at Cary Avenue Will Be Ready for Use Soon

The new Cary avenue sewage disposal plant, which is in course of construction, will be completed early this spring, according to reports from the North Shore Sanitary district officials. The Lake Forest and North Chicago plants are finished and will be opened probably in April, grading and landscaping only remaining to be completed.

The cost of these plants totals about \$225,000, and the improvements are being financed out of the bond issue passed by the sanitary district in December, 1930.

of the Winnetka Plan Commission and recommendations made to it by city planner, Edward H. Bennett in 1921, coinciding remarkably with the contentions of the various resolutions. Newspaper publicity was noted, the report showing that since May of last year some 319 column inches had been devoted to this subject by Chicago and north shore papers.

Supplementing the report was a volume of petitions signed by the owners of more than two thirds of all the property abutting on Sheridan road in Winnetka.

**Present Arguments**  
In submitting these documents, the improvement association representatives presented in detail the arguments that have been advanced in behalf of their contentions, calling especial attention to the practical unanimity of opinion on the subject throughout the north shore, and to the fact that while the Sheridan road property covered by the petitions totalled only a little more than two-thirds of the entire frontage in Winnetka, many of the property owners could not be reached owing to their present absence from home.

Chief Engineer Sheets, District Engineer Lamb, and the other highway department representatives expressed their appreciation of the manner in which the subject was presented and gave their assurance that it would receive very careful consideration. It was pointed out that while Sheridan road was apparently subject to mandatory legislation in connection with the bond issue of 1917, the practical considerations then and now were very different.
