**County Treasurers
Protected on Bond
by Law, Report**

County treasurers are protected from liability on their bonds by a law, enacted by a recent special session of the state legislature, providing for designation by the county board of a depository for county funds, whether or not the bond was filed before the law went into effect, according to an opinion by Attorney General Oscar Carlstrom issued at Springfield.

The opinion was given in response to a request from Assistant State's Attorney George S. McGaughey of Lake county.

In answer to another question by McGaughey, Carlstrom informed him that there has been no change in the statute requiring boards of supervisors to organize after the regular date for election of supervisors for the coming year.

**Libertyville Aviator
Injured April 2, Dies
in Racine Hospital**

Charles Landis, 25 year old Waukegan aviator, died early last week at St. Luke's hospital, Racine, after a losing five day battle against injuries he sustained in a plane crash west of Racine, Saturday morning, April 2, in which his companion, Lyle Eldridge of Antioch, was instantly killed.

Death was caused by a double fracture of the skull from which Landis failed to rally despite the efforts of Dr. H. G. Brehm of Racine and Dr. L. E. Bovik of Waukegan who tried every known means of lessening the pressure on the brain.

On Monday night, after holding to his even chance for recovery, Landis started sinking and later hospital authorities were convinced that he could not recover. Death came at 3 o'clock Wednesday morning.

Landis was one of the most popular members of the Waukegan Flying club. He held a commercial pilot's license from the United States Department of Commerce and was considered an excellent flier. He was known to be fearless in the air and until two years ago when he fractured his right ankle in a parachute jump at the National Air Races at Glenview he was, frequently engaged to make daring parachute leaps at many expositions throughout the middle west.

Charles Landis was born at Hinsdale, Ill., July 9, 1906, the son of John P. and Bertha E. Landis. The family moved to Libertyville in 1915.
