DRUCE LAKE CAMP BENEFIT PROJECT

Plants from Famous Garden to Be Sold to Aid Worthy Charity; Details

This year's activities on behalf of Druce Lake camp are being started by the board of directors with a selling of perennial plants from the famous private gardens of Mrs. H. S. Hicks of Rockford. It will give gardening people an opportunity to help the handicapped children that Druce Lake brings back to happiness, with no further outlay than their investment in a well-known exceptionally choice grade of plants.

Landscape artists and Garden club members have long known the advantages of driving out to these enchanting gardens and their choosing plants from their own attractive locations on the hill-slopes of beside the winding walks under the trees. Ideas are to be had from merely seeing how Mrs. Hicks combines colors and forms and treats exposures, and she asks nothing better than to say garden information in any fertile garden-lover's mind. Plants from here are extra well-grown, strong, and with root-clumps of a size that are a surprise.

Imported Varieties
French and English importations and the newest and most interesting varieties, rarely obtainable, are Mrs. Hicks' main interest. For example: Christmas roses, the loveliest imaginable pink poppies, blooming vines of wisteria, tuberose, single white, for modern effects, hybrid hemerocallis, early, medium and late, splendid wild-flower plants, baptisia for accent, trolius, a fine little-used flower, yuccas, the high spot of modern decorative art, Phlox nowhere more beautiful, as well as several specialties such as rare French lilacs on their own roots, small hawthorns, and wild plum-trees for landscape effect or espaliered on trellis or wall.

Visiting these gardens would be a liberal education if only to make the acquaintance of "Jim," the Sicilian in attendance with the spade. Jim is an artist in his own right,

but he is also the finished product of Mrs. Hicks' teaching. He is an expert in that rare accomplishment, hoeing, not just hoeing but hoeing as it should be done but practically never is. And if you wish to see a virtuoso performer practising his special talents, watch Jim lift your plants so they never know they have been moved, deftly tucking the wrappings around them Japanese-fashion—none of the men who work with him can do that—and stowing them so they take hardly any room in your car.

How to Get There
The gardens are two hours west of Lake Forest and Highland Park. Go by Woodstock, Harvard and Caledonia. This is easier than to go through the city of Rockford. Short detour off the cement road in Caledonia. Route 173 after that to its end. Turn left into Rockford. Mrs. Hicks' house is at the top of the hill on the edge of town just after passing the bridge on the right. The telephone is Parkside 327.

Spring in Rockford is a week or ten days earlier than on the north shore, and plants soon get too big to move. The first warm days suggest a picnic lunch thrown in the back of the car and an objective toward the country.
