Church Claims Recount Will Prove Him to Be Congressional Winner

Ralph Church in a statement declares that he is the winner of the Republican nomination for Congress in the 10th district. He is basing this contention on the fact that he has in the opinion of his organization the best set of precinct returns on this congressional race. His figures show him a winner of the contest by over 700 votes.

The Lake county canvass has been completed by County Clerk Lew Hendee. The final figures there give Church a lead over James Simpson, Jr., of 201 votes from figures previously announced. The final figures for this contest from Lake county are Simpson 6,692; Church 5,247. The previous figures given out in Lake county were Simpson 6,990 and Church 5,344, a net gain for Church over Simpson of 201 votes.

The Cook county canvass is now under way. The officials at the County building here in Chicago started to verify the Evanston precinct figures yesterday. It is re-

ported Church picked up gains in yesterday's canvass.

Mr. Church left for Springfield last evening to attend the special session of the legislature. He has been loath to issue a statement on the contest until all the canvassing figures were announced. When told that he owed it to his loyal supporters to say something, Mr. Church issued the following statement:

"It was not my intention to make a public statement on the outcome of the congressional race in the 10th district until the canvassing boards had completed their work. In view of the fact, however, that despite my early acquired lead, the impression seems to prevail in some quarters that James Simpson, Jr., is the winner in this race, I feel called upon to say in answer to questions from many of my loyal supporters that I am convinced that I shall win this contest by over 700 votes. The discrepancy in the figures as announced for Mr. Simpson, Jr., is evidently due to the fact that the count from a large number of precincts, including some Evanston precincts, was omitted in the early returns. This fact, plus the knowledge that Mr. Simpson's lead in Lake county was further reduced by 201 votes in the Lake county official canvass completed yesterday, makes me confident that the official Cook county canvass will give me the election by a safe margin of over 700 votes."

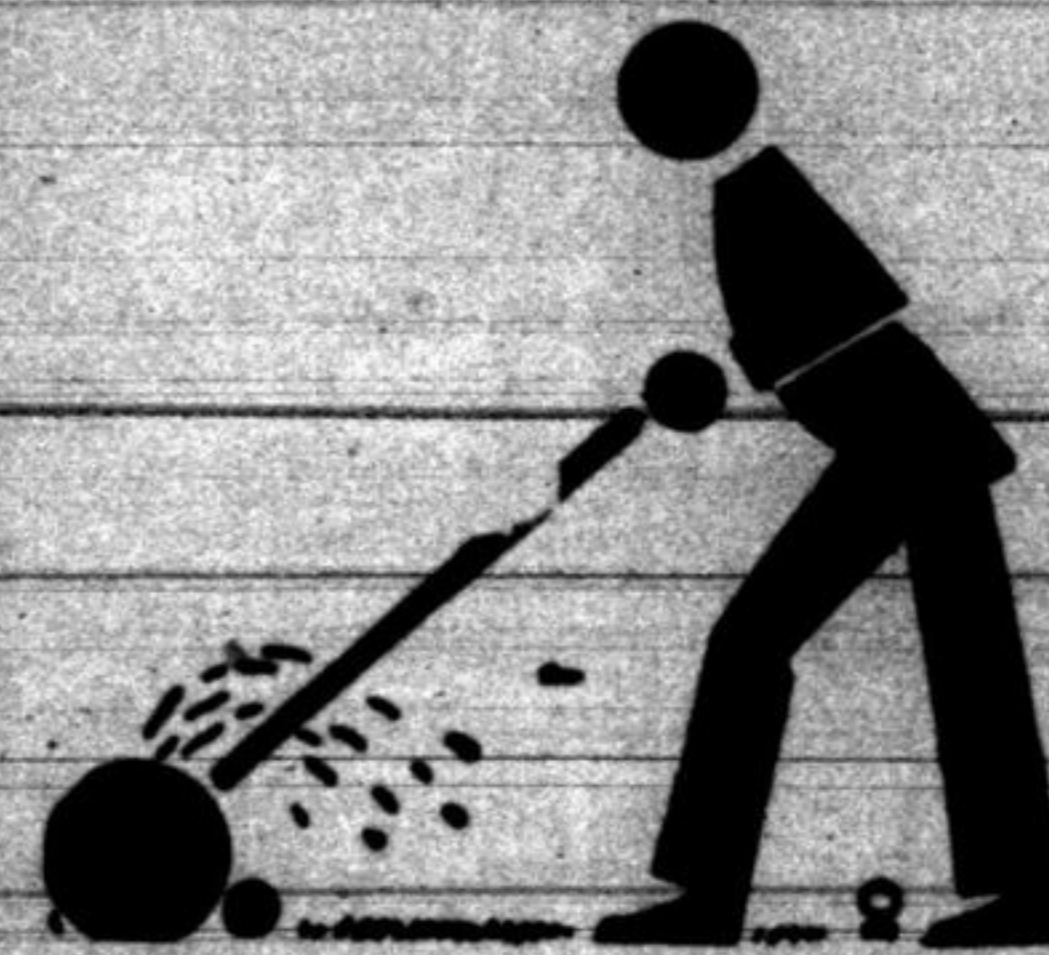
