





#### PENAL FIGURES IN STATE SHOWS GAIN

#### More Inmates in Institutions Last Year Than Year Before, Report

Population of Illinois state penal institutions for the year on April 1, last, totaled 11,055, an increase of 5.43 per cent as compared with the year ending April 1, 1931, according to figures, made available here today by the State Department of Public Welfare.

Greatest increase was recorded at the New State Woman's Reformatory at Dwight, where 133 women were reported incarcerated last month as compared to 43 in April 1931. The increase however, it was pointed out, is due to the fact that most of the inmates were brought there from the Old Woman's Prison at Joliet where all women, convicted of crimes had been sent previously. Eventually it is planned to transfer all women violators to Dwight.

#### Pontiac Reformatory

Next to the woman's reformatory, was the state reformatory for men under 321 at Pontiac where the population in 1932 represented was 2,811 an increase of 357 over the number in 1931.

According to penal statistics the increased number of inmates at Pontiac was due to crimes involving robbery. Surveys of causes leading to crimes by inmates of the Pontiac institution attribute blame mostly to lack of religion and economics.

According to Col. Fred D. Whipp, superintendent of state prisons, housing conditions at the Southern Illinois State Penitentiary at Menard have been relieved by the completing of two galleries of a new cell house, giving accommodations to 400 convicts, 200 to each gallery. The cell house, when completed, will have five galleries accommodating 1,000 convicts.
