### County Board Plans To Accept State Aid For Veterinarian Pay

Accepting the offer of the state to pay a portion of the salary of the county veterinarian, the Agricultural committee of the county board of supervisors has prepared a resolution for adoption when the board convenes this week.

The state will pay \$150 monthly toward the salary of Dr. T. P. Galahue from Sept. 1 until June 30, 1933 when the fund will be exhausted.

The Agricultural committee, composed of Supervisors H. C. W. Meyer, Mundelein, and James O'Connor, Deerfield, and Assistant Supervisor Walter E. Diesner met with Dr. Gallahue recently to discuss the proposed relief for the county before preparing the resolution.

Four dance hall owners have filed application with the county board for permits to operate through the year. The fee is \$25. Those filing applications are: Night Owl, Fox Lake; Austin Stables, Green Bay road, near Waukegan; H. O. Meyer's dance hall, Fox Lake, and Winch pavilion, at Channel Lake.

The name of Earle H. Gray, colored, Waukegan lawyer last week was officially stricken from the roll of attorneys of Illinois when the supreme court made absolute his disbarment, according to press advices from Springfield.

### Waukegan Paper Says Bond of Snyder Was Forfeited in Default

The bond of \$500 posted for Clifford Snyder of Deerfield, before Justice Henry Wallenwein on a charge of false arrest, last week was forfeited by Justice Henry Wallenwein when Snyder failed to appear for the hearing, says the Waukegan News-Sun.

Wallenwein was advised that Snyder was on his way west and with him was Leonard Meyers, a co-defendant.

The bondsman was George Charon.

Edith Wolf, of Highland Park, a friend of Snyder, signed the complaint. She said that she advanced him \$500 to get a surety bond when he was in jail on a charge of labor racketeering. She said that Snyder turned over his car to her for the \$500, according to the Waukegan newspaper.

After his conviction, along with Leonard Murphy and Charles Heintzelman, Snyder went to her, she claims, and demanded the return of his car. She refused and he and Meyers and Constable Frank Sherry took her before Justice Walter Wright where she claims she was forced to tell where the car was located.

Frank Dolph, veteran town clerk of Ivanhoe, sustained three fractured ribs and painful bruises recently when a gravel truck he was driving got out of control and swerved to the roadside where it crashed into a tree.
