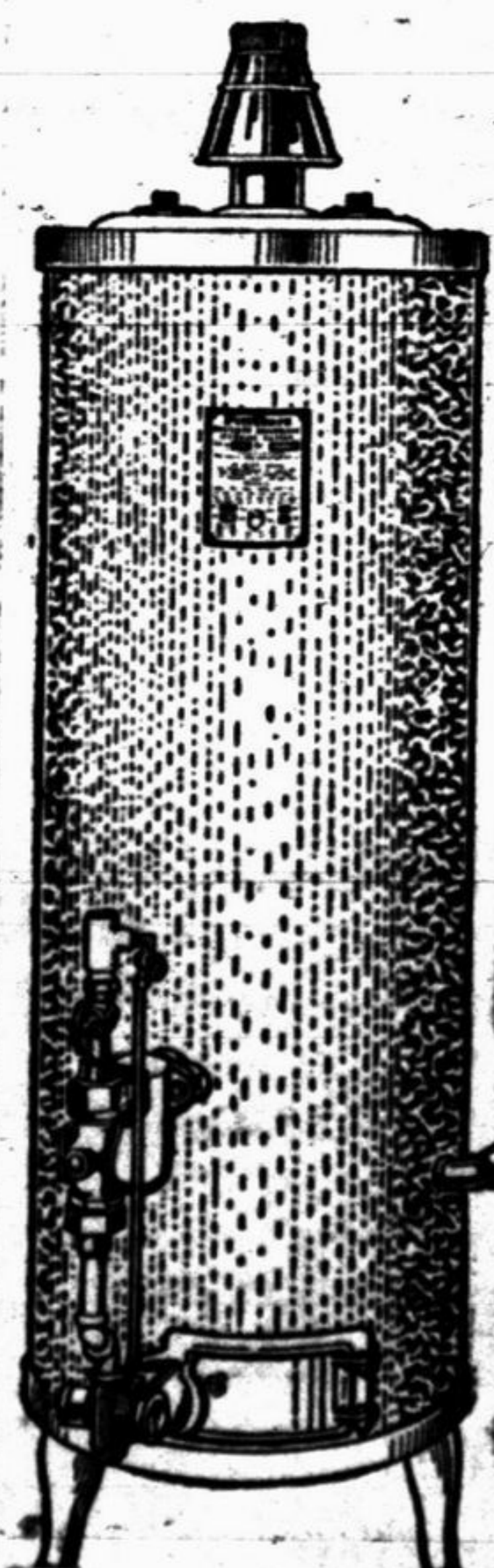

**Cardinal to Dedicate
Grayslake New Church
on July 3rd, Report**

His Eminence George Cardinal Mundelein will dedicate the new Catholic parish in Grayslake July 3 in an elaborate church program that has been planned for the event.

The parish is the youngest in the county and about as robust in membership in view of its years as it has 42 families.

Although the first services were held there June 12 by Rev. Joseph F. Barrett, the priest in the parish, the dedicatory ceremonial all will be predicated around the visit of Cardinal Mundelein.

At the dedication there will be a host of dignitaries of the church who will assist in solemnizing the occasion.

St. Gilbert's church was conceived several years ago but construction of the edifice did not start until little more than one year in existence.

The building was erected at a cost exceeding \$16,000 and the architectural design embodies all the grace and dignity of a place of worship. It is finished in brick inside and out and constructed around steel girders that avoid interior pillars in the halls.
