**CHRISTIAN SCIENCE CHURCH ANNUAL MEET**

**Held in Mother Church at Boston Last Week; Address of Retiring President**

The steady progress of the Christian Science movement during a year marked by a general slowing down in human activities was emphasized in reports presented at the Annual Meeting of The Mother Church, The First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston, Massachusetts last week, says the Christian Science Monitor. Members from many parts of the world — more than 6,000 in all—listened to reports of the various departments of the organization which told of steady attainment in its numerous activities.

Close at hand, in the shadow of the dome of the church edifice,

members beheld an inspiring indication of this growth in a structural outline of steel and stone rapidly taking form into the new home of The Christian Science Publishing Society, designed to serve an increasing need for the promotion and publication of the periodicals.

**Retiring President Speaks**  
 The retiring President, Mr. Bufum, addressed the meeting as follows:

Dear Fellow Members: In these days when the searchlight of Truth is being turned upon the darkest corners of materialism and lawlessness, and people and nations are being tested as never before, it is a comfort to know that God governs, and that harmony, health, abundance, and peace are available to all, despite all the seeming discord. These vexatious times are forcing mankind to seek help and comfort in the law of God given in the Bible and made clear by the teachings of Christian Science.

No doubt this is one of the principal reasons why people are turning to Christian Science as never before. Christian Science is giving the knowledge and wisdom which is the strength of salvation and the stability of our times.

**Purposes Outlined**  
 The world needs the compassionate prayer of all Christian Scientists. A brighter, happier day is coming—it is indeed at hand, and those who have caught the vision have the great opportunity to spread this glorious gospel of good will and healing. All the organized activities of this church are but instrumentalities for the accomplishment of this great purpose of ministering to the sick, distressed, and sinning. With this goal always in mind, our church will continue to grow and prosper.

We are grateful that the world is beginning to recognize and appreciate, at least to a slight extent, the greatness and wisdom of our Leader, Mary Baker Eddy, and the magnitude of her unselfish work for mankind. As the years go by, our own gratitude for our Leader increases and deepens.

At this time when lawlessness and crime seem so evident, it is imperative that we, as Christian Scientists, firmly stand on the side of law and order and that we unreservedly support righteous gov-

ernment by our every thought, word, and deed. **Two Men Killed in Crossing Crash at N. Chicago; One Hurt**
