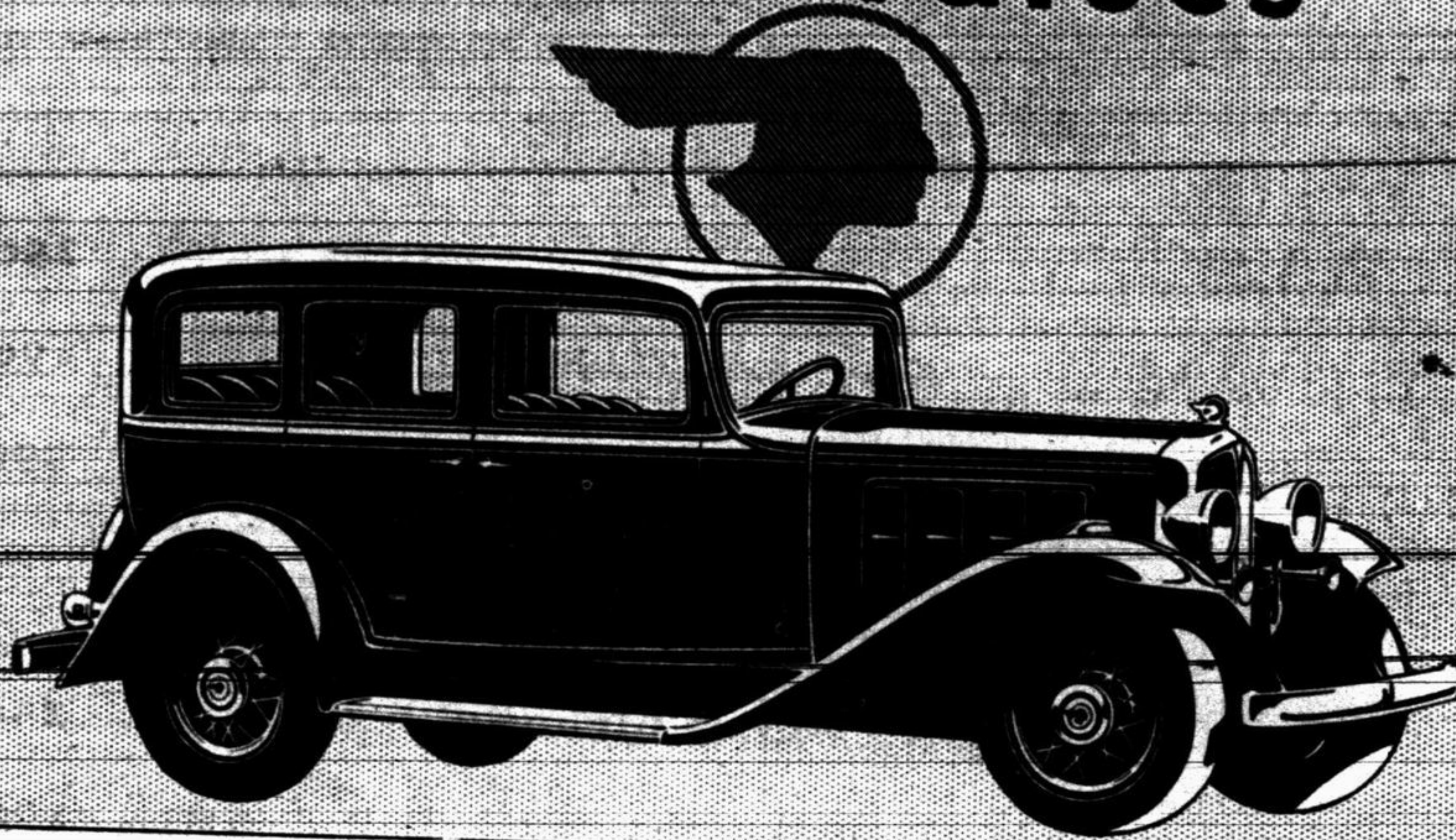

### COUNCIL DECIDES TO REVISE CITY BUDGET

vote in both cases was unanimous. Corporation Counsel Ernest S. Gail then outlined some of the problems of municipal government, pointing out that heavy cost of past improvements, demanded by the people, must still be paid for. He declared that a horizontal reduction in governmental expenditures should be obtained from township, county, state and national bodies, as well as from cities.

#### To Prepare Measure

The members of the Highland Park City club, the Deerfield Township Taxpayers' association and the Ridgewood Drive Improvement association will meet with the council to iron out differences and draft a new ordinance. Another open meeting of the council will be held Monday night, when definite action is expected.

R. T. Mack of the City club last night presented the proposed salary and appropriation ordinances. Other speakers included Xavier Vigeant, Herman Denzel and C. N. Kimball. The meeting was harmonious, members of the council and the taxpayers mutually promising co-operation to solve the municipal problems.

#### Suggested Changes

Major proposals of the suggested plan were:

Elimination of appropriation for a new fire station, incinerator, library fund; 20 instead of 10 per cent cut for certain employees; 10 per cent cut for police, with elimination of the two newest members of the force, placing of desk sergeants on patrol duty and engaging low-salaried clerks for the latter positions, replacing the fourteen full-time firemen with eight full-time men and ten part-time men, elimination of the position of motion picture censor, elimination of a full-time building inspector and merging his duties with that of water department engineer.
