Good for older members of the family with little interest for children.

The second film, The Rich Are Always with Us is a silly title for a rather good story. Well acted, highly sophisticated dialogue, playing up strongly the instability of marriage. Interesting for adults, but decidedly not for the young.

On Tuesday and Wednesday, July 5 and 6: Night Court is a highly sensational picture of a crooked, immoral and unscrupulous judge and the tricky methods of court procedure. Adults should see it, but very unwholesome for the young.
