D.A.R. Better Films Committee Review

The films of the Alcyon this week bring some pictures of interest to children, and some to make the adult think. A very interesting week.

Thursday and Friday, June 30 & July 1, *It's Tough to Be Famous*, and *The Trial of Vivienne Ware*.

In the first picture, Douglas Fairbanks Jr. does some excellent work in a satirical farce about the high-pressure publicity stunts a really modest hero has to endure. This is amusing for the young and good for the children.

In *The trial of Vivienne Ware*, circumstantial evidence substantiates the prosecuting attorney's contention that Vivienne Ware murdered her fiance. If the public resents the practice of turning the court into a three ring circus of sensational newspaper and radio reporters, the picture serves its purpose. For adults.

Saturday, July 2: *Huddle* presents a young Italian going from a steel workers' home to Yale, where he suffers much for his crudity. Grit, and nerve, make him a football hero. This film is probably good for the youths and children.

Sunday and Monday, July 3 and 4: *Lena Rivers* and *The Rich Are Always with Us*. The first film is a wholesome picture of the unhappiness that taints the life of an illegitimate child, with pathos, character interest and live humor. Good for older members of the family with little interest for children.

The second film, *The Rich Are Always with Us* is a silly title for a rather good story. Well acted, highly sophisticated dialogue, playing up strongly the instability of marriage. Interesting for adults, but decidedly not for the young.

On Tuesday and Wednesday, July 5 and 6: *Night Court* is a highly sensational picture of a crooked, immoral and unscrupulous judge and the tricky methods of court procedure. Adults should see it, but very unwholesome for the young.
