

When You Cash a Check

When you go to your local bank and cash or deposit a check for \$100, drawn on a Los Angeles bank, let us say, you may wonder why the teller makes a charge of a few cents for "exchange."

For you the transaction is complete. It has not occurred to you that your bank has actually advanced you \$100 of its own money for a week or ten days, until it can get the \$100 back from

the bank in Los Angeles, meanwhile losing the interest on this amount.

Furthermore, during this process of collection your check must be entered, the proper forms made out, mailed, verified and otherwise handled by many people.

So the few cents "exchange" merely reimburses the bank for the expense incurred in giving you a valuable service.

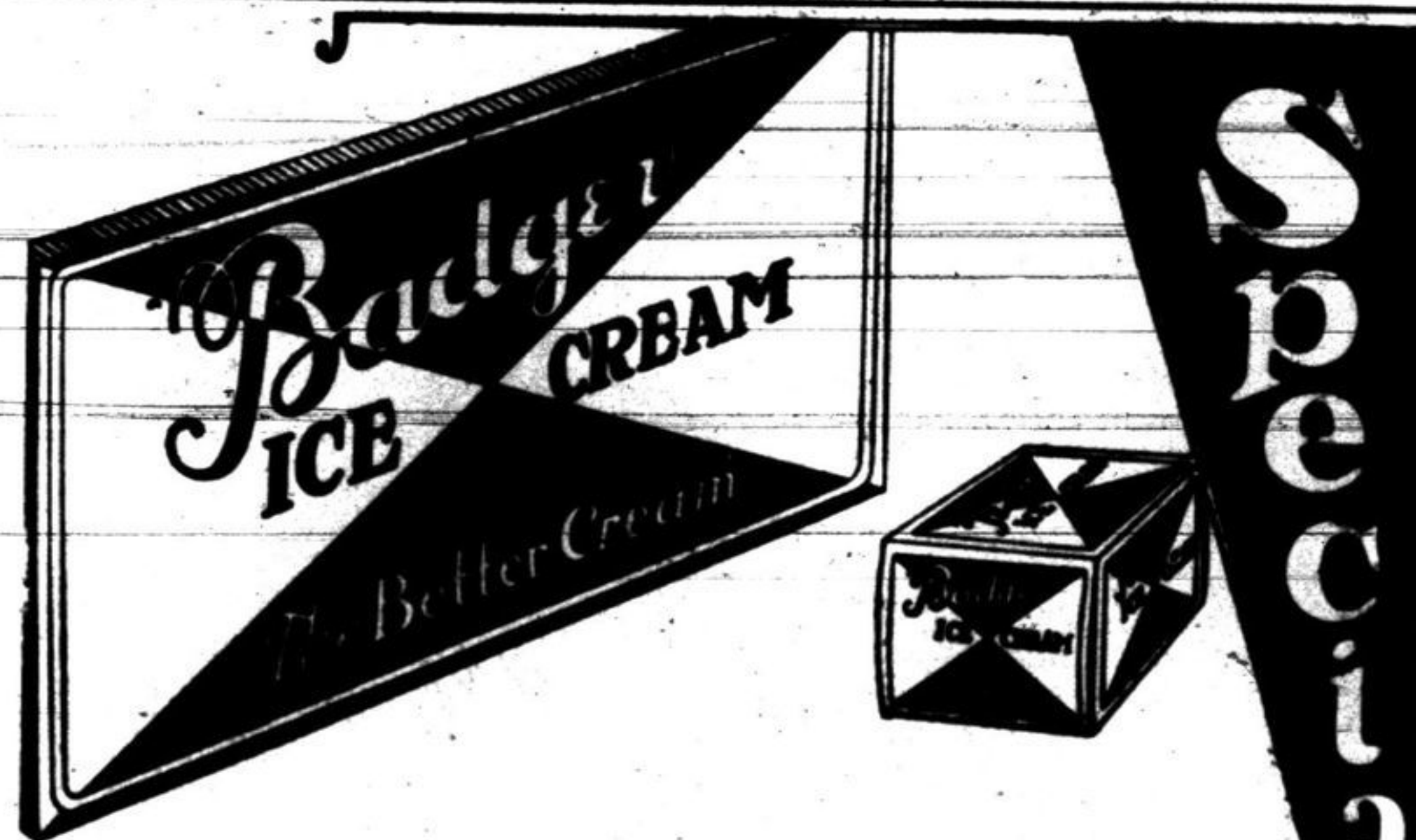
