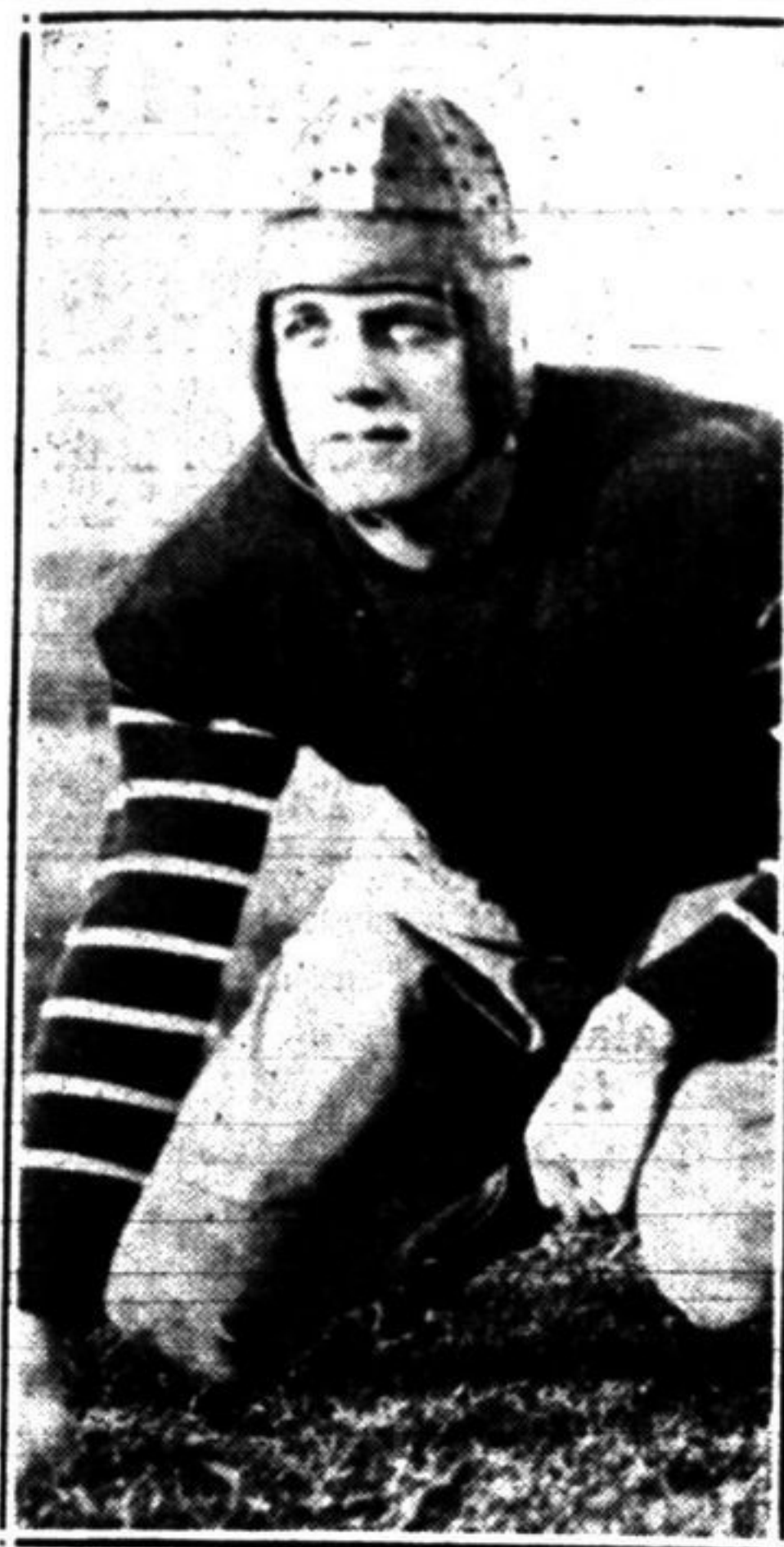

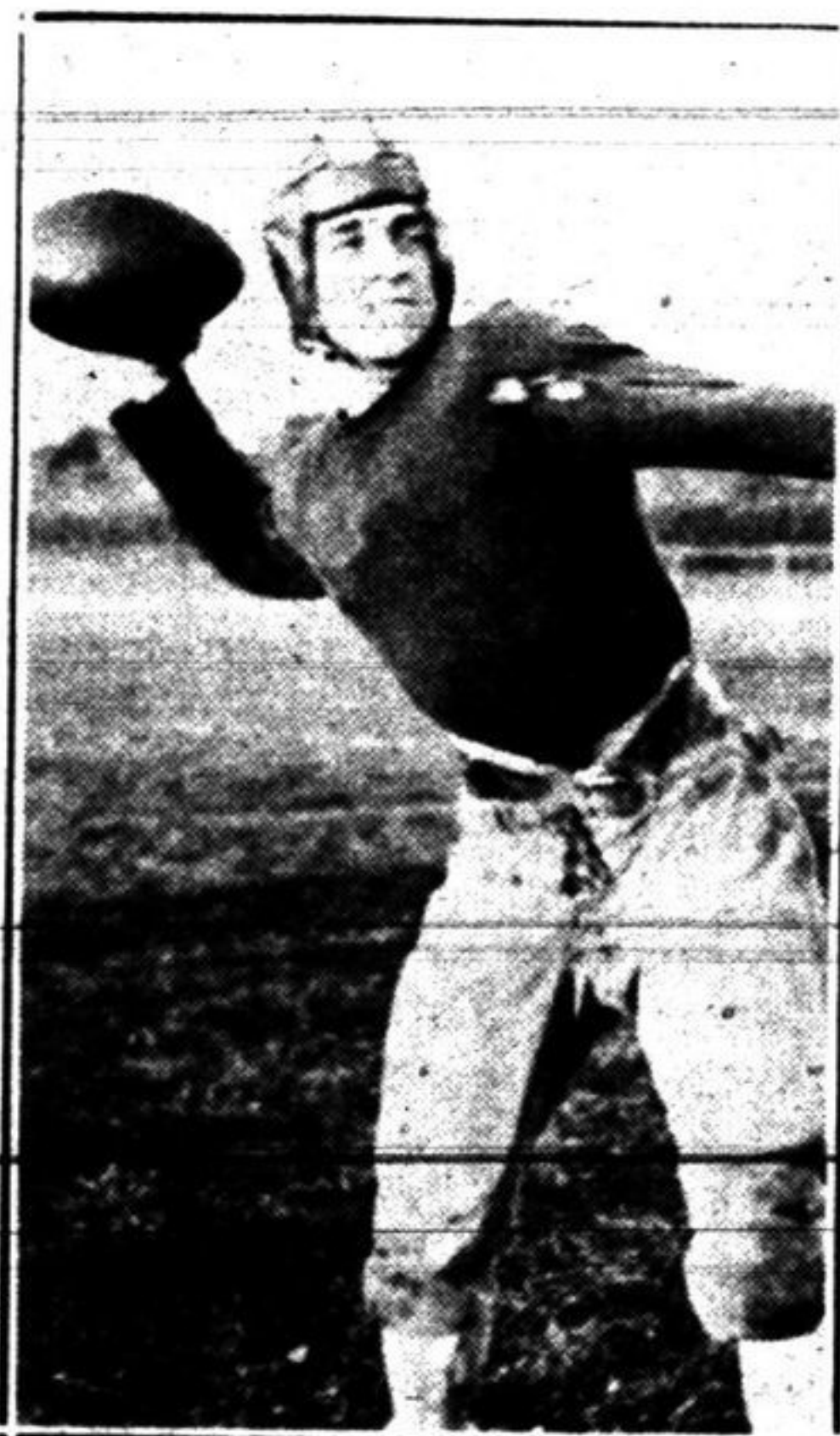

CONFIDENT BLUE AND WHITE SQUAD INVADES -STRONG MORTON HIGH

Hope for Victory After Good Showing Against Oak Park

Hoping to repeat last year's victory, Coach "Solly" Thurston and his squad of spunky fellows will invade Morton high school of Cicero next Saturday.

Morton has a much stronger team this year than it had last year. A good example of this may be seen in Evanston's victory over Morton by the slim score of 12-0.

The team that Morton will put on the field against Deerfield will be practically the same team that the Deerfield frosh-soph team faced last year. Morton has few regulars back and relies almost entirely on the strength and experience of these young players. The team that will be against Deerfield will probably be as follows: Merkle and Sokolike,

ends; Matkozviak and Batchitis, tackles, Sheenk and Pongo, guards; and Mourek, center. The backfield has Iverson as fullback, Saukup and Biltk as halves, and De Rango as quarterback.

So far this season Morton has managed to come out on the long end of the score in most of the games.

Deerfield will use practically the same lineup against Morton that it used against Oak Park. Many who didn't succeed in seeing action last Saturday may be in against Morton. Both teams will be in top shape and a good game is predicted. It is the hope of the school that many students will follow and support the team in the coming game Saturday.
