## May Seek Indictments Post Office Building for Breaking Out Jail

Indictments charging three of the bank robbers with jail breaking will be asked of the December grand jury by State's Attorney A. V. Smith it was reported in Waukegan.

Two of the men who escaped, Clifford Heaney and Ernest Ruprecht, are back in jail, recaptured two hours after they escaped October 13.

Joseph Beck, 19 years old, of 5407 Justine street, Chicago, the third member of the party, still is a fugitive.

Sheriff Lester T. Tiffany sent out 5,000 notices of the jail break to police departments of the country. These folders show a picture of Beck, give a fingerprint classification, and description. No reward is offered, as the county board of supervisors have not acted. Tiffany posted \$100 on Beck's head for the first day when it was thought he was in the ravine, and hundreds of residents took up the man hunt.

Ruprecht told the jailers that they decided to take a chance on getting away as they felt certain they would spend 20 years in the penitentiary.

"Feeling against us here is high, and on a sentence of one year to life we will be in the penitentiary for 20 years with no chance of getting out. We know now that our last chance is gone as we would not get 50 feet out of this place now without being mowed down with machine guns. We were treated decently in jail but our only course was to try and make a getaway or stand the prospects of spending the rest of our lives in prison," Ruprecht said.

## Women Must Sign Own Names Upon Petitions

In signing petitions women voters must sign their own names and not their husband's name, Attorney General Oscar E. Carlstrom advised State's Attorney George D. Carbary of Kane county.

The question, according to Carbary, arose regarding signers to a petition for discontinuance of township organization in Kane county. Carlstrom approved Carbary's interpretation of the law that the correct signature is "Mary Doe" and not "Mrs. John Doe."
