
Waukegan Schools May Get Aid from R.F.C., According to Report

The Reconstruction Finance Corporation may bring aid to the Waukegan public school system to solve a financial crisis which at present threatens to bring payless paydays for the entire educational staff.

Both school boards meeting in a joint session last week voted unanimously to make application to the federal finance corporation for a loan and Secretary John E. Reardon was named to confer with the officials of the organization at once, and to take such steps as may be necessary to complete arrangements for a loan if it is possible to get one.
