Santi Bros. Dairy are in first place in the league, having won 12 games and having lost 3.

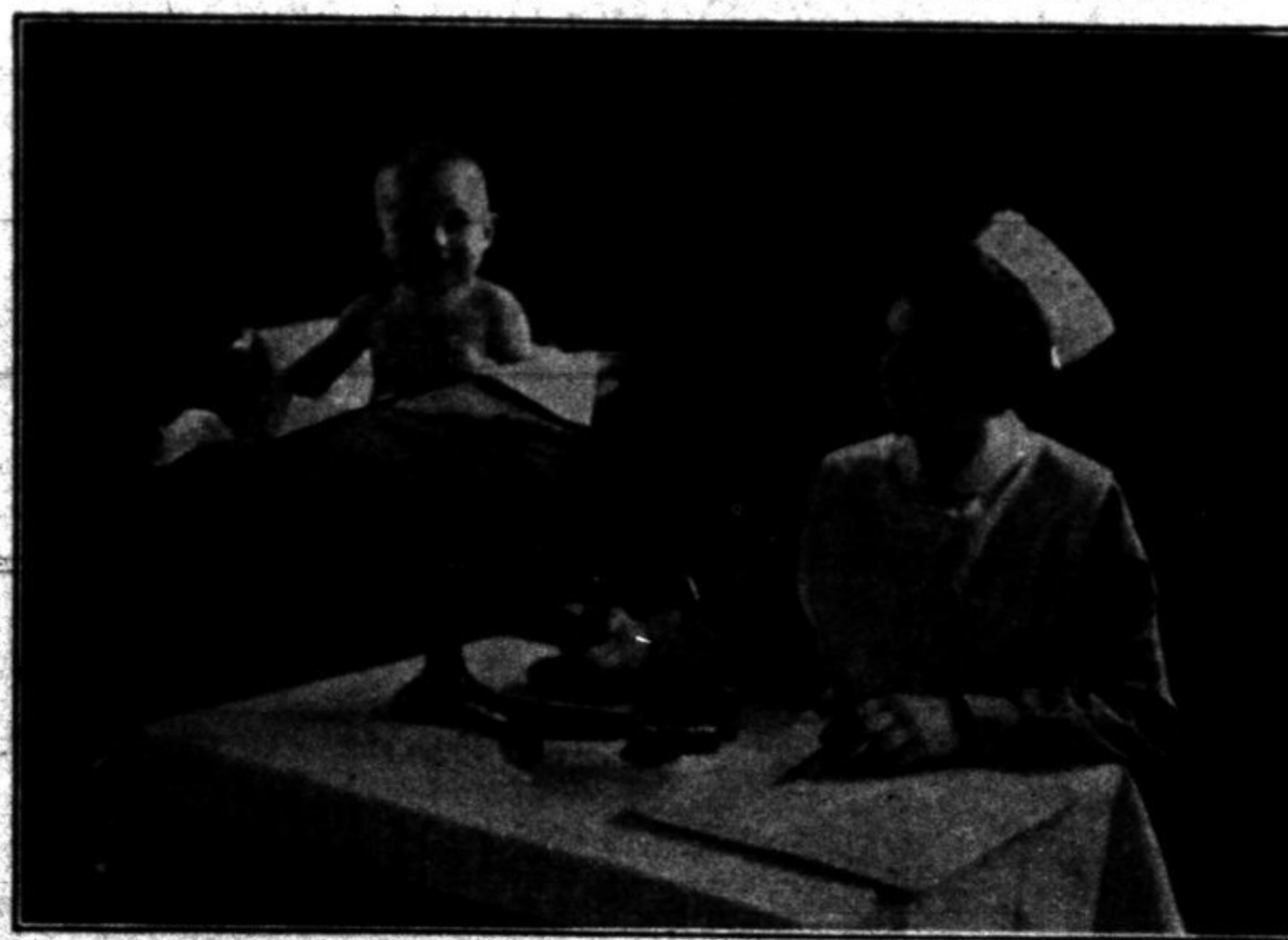
